"TIGER" BURNS, GAME LITTLE K. F. SCRAPER, MAY BE BACK FROM EAST FOR BOUT IN MAY

Announcement was made last night that Promoter R. E. Patterson of the Scandinavian hall, has just about closed a deal to get "Tiger" Burns, one of the scrappiest scrappers in the game, and holder of the bantam title of the Pacific Coast, to fight here in the next card after the one Tuesday. The announcement will be greeted by ardent supporters of "Tiger," who is a Klamath Falls boy and has a host of friends here.

"Tiger" will be matched with Joe Gorman or some other opponent equally as good as Joe. "Tiger" just left for the east, where he has an engagement to scrap in Madison Square Garden April 25. But he's coming back in a few weeks, and if Patterson can match a man of the "Tiger's" calibre to trade blows with him Klamath Falls boxing will be in a class with the largest cities on the coast in the boxing world.

WHEAT SEED GROWERS TO GET PRIZES

In order to encourage growers to produce a better quality of seed wheat, special prizes aggregating \$40, have been offered by Martin Brothers flour mill, Klamath Falls. To the growers exhibiting the cleanest, purest and best sack of Barbank, marquis or bluestem, a first prize of \$25.00 is offered, to the second best, which must be on either of the other two varieties, a \$10.00 prize is offered, and to the third best, which must be of the remaining variety, a \$5.00 prize is offered. This means a prize on each of the three varieties named, but whether first, second or third to depend entirely upon quality from standpoint of seed production. Those interested in competing for these prizes should notify the county agent's office during the growing season so that the field could be inspected before harvesting. Awards will be made at the county fair, consideration being given conditions of field before harvest, quality of sack of grain on exhibit at the fair.

To those grain growers interested in improving the quality of the wheat in the Klamath basin, this offer should be of considerable importance. Better quality means better prices, and improvement can only be made by careful selection and growing of those varieties in demand.

possible the perpetration of further outrages.

The force of the explosion and the impact of heavy roofing combined to wreck the interior of the old cathedral. The panicky hundreds who sought to escape to the street added to the destruction. Those men and women who sat beneath the open spaces in the roof through which the sky suddenly had appeared were buried beneath the heavy wreckage.

Revolution Spreading
Nicola Mileff, minister designate to the United States when he was shot down in Sofia on February 1, may be avenged as a result of the police raids. During the general round-up of communists Mileff's assassin is reported to have been captured. He is alleged to be a member of the Macedonia committee, an organization credited with some of the assassinations of government supporters. He has also been linked with anarchist outbreaks in February 1924.

Scores of children are reported among the victims of the explosion. They had accompanied their parents to the sorrowful rites over Georgieff's body of which they probably understood but little.

Reservists have been called to the colors in Sofia and are reinforcing the street patrol begun by regular troops.

BELGRADE, April 17.—The anti-Zankoff revolution has succeeded in the Zankoff district according to refugees from Bulgaria who are scurrying pell-mell across the Yugoslav frontier.

It is reported here that the Sofia metropolitan patriarch of the Greek orthodox church was among those killed in the blast at the Svetikral cathedral.

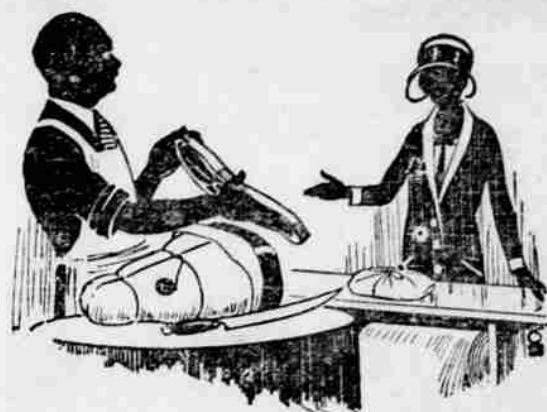
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
