

FAIRVIEW AND MILLS SCHOOLS TO BE IMPROVED

At a regular meeting of the board of directors of school district No. 1 held last evening regular routine business was transacted. W. R. Hawley and E. B. Henry, city engineer, presented to the board the advisability of dedicating to the city of Klamath Falls a small rectangular piece of the block belonging to the school in Mills Addition for the purpose of straightening out the proposed east Main street paving. Some suggestions were made as to the advantages of closing an entire street adjacent to the school property and the board instructed the chairman and the clerk to sign a deed to the city providing the two bodies could agree on certain minor details.

Mr. Wells reported the inability of two teachers to accept positions offered them. Mrs. Lois Seary and Miss Gladys Larsen. Miss Ellen Lynch was elected to teach for the ensuing year. Peter Post, the former janitor at Pelican City school, having tendered his resignation, J. H. Ogil was appointed to fill the vacancy.

Mr. Wells reported the loss of Mrs. Eva Jordan as secretary. Mrs. Jordan having accepted a position with the Klamath Dye Works. He made various recommendations for the improvement of the various properties belonging to the school during the summer. Among them being a good ornamental fence around the Mills Addition property, the leveling and calking of these grounds and the leveling and surfacing of some of the Fairview magnesian.

A large clock on a public building has been running for almost a century with little attention except cleaning and winding.

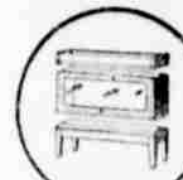
Teacher At Chemawa Indian School Admits Embezzlement of Funds

SALEM, April 20.—According to a statement made by Harwood Hall, superintendent of the Chemawa Indian school an investigation is being made of the accounts of Mrs. Sarah H. Chamberlain, who has been in the employ of the school for the past nine years. Mrs. Chamberlain has made a signed statement admitting under \$2200 in money to students at the school for her own use. It is thought that further developments in the case will take place after the school are reviewed by the Indian Service in Washington. Mrs. Chamberlain has been dismissed from the school.
