

DAWES RENEWS FIGHT ON NEW SENATE RULES

NEW YORK, April 21.—Vice President Charles G. Dawes emphasized again today that he was elected by the people of the United States to preside over the senate and delivered to American newspaper publishers his appeal for an adequate clause in the upper house he asked the people to help him through letters, resolutions and petitions to their senators.

Patting the renewal of his plea on a non-partisan basis the vice president addressing the annual luncheon of the Associated Press again demanded an end of what

is in effect and in changed form the old argument upholding the principles of monarchical and despotic government—the argument minorities or individuals know better what is good for the people than the majority of the people themselves.

Dawes reiterated that his campaign for a change in senatorial rules was his most important duty, especially because the senate had refused to effect such a change by itself.

To demonstrate the non-partisan character of his campaign, the vice president called attention to the Underwood resolution for better closure and the plank in the 1916 and 1920 democratic platforms calling for such alteration of rules procedure as would permit prompt transaction of the nation's legislative business.

"The issue," said Dawes, "is this: Rules Must Change."

"Shall the senate continue unchanged its existing rules which ad-

mittedly make possible, at times, the exercise by a minority or even one senator of power to block the purpose of the majority of the senate to legislate?"

Dawes told the publishers that the claim that such a power to block legislation some times prevented enactment of mistaken laws was irrelevant inasmuch as no such power was provided by the constitution. "A power," he said, "which at times puts into the hands of minorities and individuals the ability to modify or control legislation by barter."

"No argument is sound," he declared, "to the effect that, to protect a majority of the senate and of the American people themselves, it is necessary to put them at the mercy of either a senate minority or of any one United States senator. Any restraint upon the people imposed by a senate rule is a usurped governmental power not

found in the constitution.

Individualists

"For years," Dawes pointed out, "the average citizen has had the operations of the United States senate under his eye and he understands what is involved. He knows there is at question the possession in certain circumstances of power exercised by the president of the United States. He realized that these extra-constitutional powers which have been gradually built up and which, from time to time, he had seen exercised, and subversive of the principles of representative constitutional government."
