ORDINANCE GRANTING A FRANCHISE TO W. E. YOUNG OPERATING ON THE HIGHWAYS AND AVENUES OF KLAMATH FALLS, OREGON, STREET CARS OR TRAM CARS WITHOUT ELECTRIC OR GASOLINE POWER, OR OPERATING CAPACITY EXCEEDING 200 POUNDS, OR MORE, IN MAIN ROUTES AND BRANCH ROUTES, AND PROVIDING FOR THE FAIR REGULATION THEREOF.
