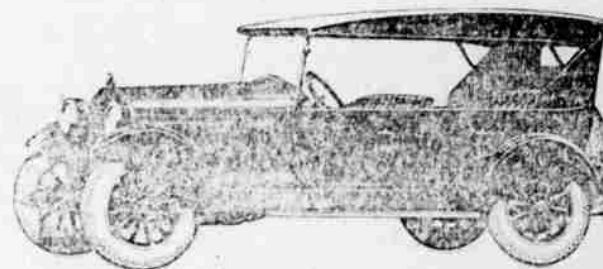

FIVE YEARS THE LIMIT
