4th day of May, 1925, filed plans,
specifications and estimates of the
cost of improving Huron street
from Pacific Terrace to El Dorado
avenue and El Dorado avenue from
Esplanade to Huron street, includ-
ing intersection with Huron street,
and the council having taken same
under advisement and finding said
plans, specifications and estimates
to be satisfactory;
BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED
that said plans, specifications and
estimates for the improvement of
the said portions of said streets be
