"There is no other way in the world for you to leave the ship," replied the captain. Mrs. Fitzmaurice finally climbed.

'NORSE' STAMPS TO BE OUT SOON

WASHINGTON, May 13.—Postmaster General New announced today that the first issue of the new Norse-American stamps, to commemorate the arrival in New York on October 9, 1825, of the ship "Restaurationen" with the first group of immigrants from Norway to the United States will be placed on sale May 18, 1925. The stamps will be on sale at St. Paul, Minneapolis, Benson, and Northfield, Minn., Algona, and Decorah, Iowa, and Washington, D. C.

These stamps will be issued in two denominations, 2 cent and 5 cent. The 2 cent stamp has for its central design a ship representing

the sloop "Restaurationen" with a smaller vessel in the background. At the top of the stamp, in a straight panel, appear the words "Norse-American" in white Roman letters, and below this, on a curved ribbon, is the word "Centennial" in dark letters. Ribbon scrolls appear in the upper portion on each side of the stamp with the years "1825" at the left and "1925" at the right. At the bottom of the stamp, in three straight lines, are the words "United States Postage Two Cents," and in both lower corners, within circles with backgrounds, is the white numeral "2". The central design is printed in black with the border design printed in red.

The 5-cent stamp has for its central design a Viking ship. At the top of the stamp, in white Gothic letters, appear the words "Norse-American" and below this, on a curved ribbon, is the word "Centennial" in dark letters.

BIG FILM TRUST TO BE BATTLED BY INDEPENDENTS

MILWAUKEE, May 13.—Protest against "a mighty film trust" of monopoly, which threatens to crush thousands of business men in the motion picture industry, alternated with rumors that a split had taken place in the ranks of the Independent Producers and Exhibitors' association, as that body continued its convention here today.

The producers and exhibitors, together with the independent picture theater owners of America, have met in Milwaukee to prepare for war on the larger motion picture corporations, which they charge with dominating the field and crowding out small concerns.

Whether they will break up in internal dispute without launching the war remained problematical to night, but scheduled activities of the season were postponed, while hints of a mysterious split prevailed.

Boa Constrictor
Sol Levitan, Wisconsin state treasurer, heartened the independents late in the day with a speech, picturing the alleged "film trust" as a "boa constrictor monopoly."

"The damming influence of this movie trust goes much further than just to the people who are engaged in the moving picture business," he said. "It touches almost every man, woman and child in the country, for America goes to the movies nowadays. The motion picture is probably the greatest invention of the age."

Levitan charged that big picture corporations are "grabbing up as

many theaters as they can get their hands on," and that "such competition which has been detrimental to the industry, and has been a public enemy of the people."

The arrival at the Milwaukee Artists, has led to the Mary Pickford, Douglas Fairbanks, Charlie Chaplin and the rest of the United Artists' alliance themselves with the independent faction.
