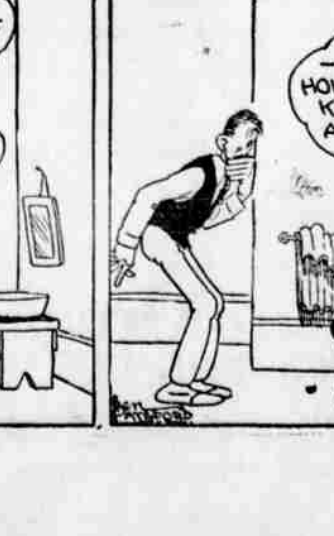

ORDINANCE NO.— ORDINANCE GRANTING A FRANCHISE TO W. E. YOUNG FOR OPERATING ON THE STREETS, HIGHWAYS AND AVENUES OF KLAMATH FALLS, OREGON, STREET CARS OR BUSES WITHOUT TRACKS OR RAILS, USING ELECTRIC, STEAM OR GASOLINE POWER, HAVING A SEATING CAPACITY OF TWENTY (20) OR MORE PASSENGERS, OPERATED OVER MAIN ROUTES AND SMALLER CARS ON BRANCH OR FEEDER ROUTES, AND PROVIDING FOR THE FARES TO BE CHARGED AND FOR THE REGULATION THEREOF. THE CITY OF KLAMATH FALLS ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

Section I. The word "grantee" wherever used herein shall be understood to refer to W. E. Young, his successors or assigns, as hereinafter mentioned, and the word "city" shall refer to the city of Klamath Falls, Oregon, and the Common Council thereof.

Section II. There is hereby granted to W. E. Young, his successors or assigns, the right, privilege and franchise to operate street cars or buses, without

tracks or rails, using electric, steam or gasoline power, over and upon the streets, avenues, highways and districts within the city of Klamath Falls, Oregon; provided, however, that but one assignment or transfer shall be made of this franchise.

Section III. Cars operating on main route or routes shall be provided with seats for not less than twenty (20) persons, exclusive of the driver. No street cars having an external width over all in excess of seven and one-half (7 1/2) feet shall be used by the grantee unless the type of such car shall first be approved by the Common Council.
