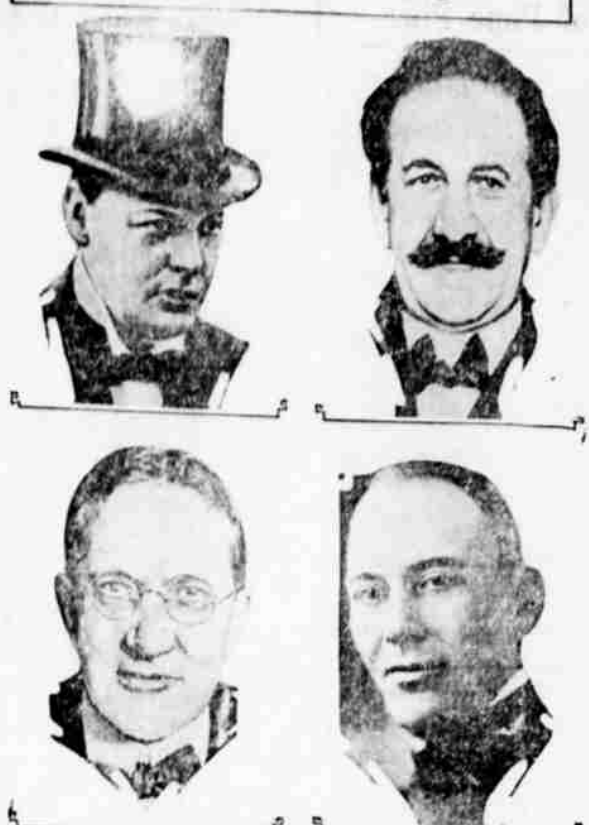


Figures in the News



Winston Churchill, Chancellor of the Exchequer, announced Great Britain would return to the gold standard immediately and payment of \$100,000,000 would be made on its debt to the United States. Samuel Untermyer, noted lawyer in a speech at a New York banquet, assailed Professor Philip Marshall Brown, of Princeton University, for his attack on the Jews as lacking patriotism. Senator Moses, Republican of New Hampshire, president pro tem of the Senate, declared Vice President Dawes would get no aid from him in his campaign to change rules of the Senate. Brigadier-General James F. Fesnet, who succeeded Col. Mitchell as Chief of the Air Service, stated that the air forces should eventually be separated from army and navy control.

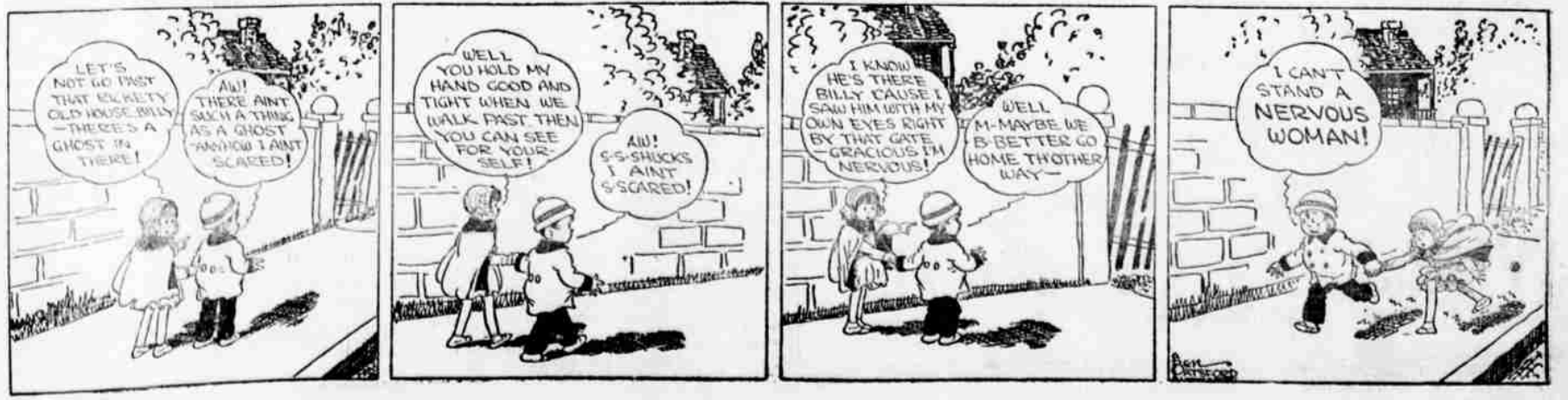
