

FAVORITE SLAVE GIRL OF RICH FRISCO CHINAMAN IS LIBERATED BY BRAVERY OF CHARITY WORKER

SAN FRANCISCO, May 19.—Chan, greedy and unprincipled, sold his young wife to the keeper of a brothel. Miss Cameron led a raid for Chan, and the couple left San Francisco. Chan was taken to a hospital, where her baby was born.

The story of Chan is one of intrigue, treachery and lust, and of the bravery of two American mission workers.

Chan was brought here four years ago as the child-bride of Lum Quong. Her pretty innocence attracted the attention of Miss Cameron of the Presbyterian Chinese mission.

Within a few months Quong,

Then Quong, cloaking his evil with self-spoken promises, returned for Chan, and the couple left San Francisco. Miss Cameron lost all trace of the girl until three years ago, when she found her ill in Chicago. Chan was spirited away and it was not until last spring that she was located again.

Tom Ling, another of Miss Cameron's proteges, attended a long

banquet in Chicago, and Chan, the slave girl, danced. They had known each other here and Chan begged Ling to rescue her. All Ling's possessions were mortgaged to obtain the \$500 which the Ong Leons demanded. But Ling bought Chan and Mrs. Ling cared for her. That procedure brought the tongmen after more money. Ling agreed to give up the girl and to pay \$125 a week for the assurance that Chan would not be mistreated. He locked her in a room and hurried here to ask Miss Cameron's advice.

Miss Ethel Higgins, another mission worker, started east with a key to Chan's room. She braved the dangers of Chicago's Chinatown and brought Chan out without even calling in police for help.

All of these details which smack more of fiction than of actuality, came out in evidence Monday when Miss Cameron appeared in court to take over the custody of Chan's son

Stewart. He will remain at the mission while his mother goes back to relatives in China.

Chan was willing to give up her art because in the Orient she would belong to his father. And she does not want him to fall into the hands of the man who made her a slave. She wants him to be an American.

drove a spike into the top of his head with a hammer, and is now dying in a hospital. Houtz, it is thought, was dependent over his poor health, and a fear that he would lose his mind.

WHITE PLAINS, N. Y., May 19.—Miss Jennie Fava, 22, is on trial here for the embezzlement of \$15,000 from the department store for which she worked as a bookkeeper. She is alleged to have used the \$15,000 to put her sweetheart through college.

NEWARK, N. J., May 19.—Bobbing is barbering. Virginia Gentile said his barber shop to Victor Dellacorte on a contract providing that he would not re-enter the barbering business for five years. Then Dellacorte charged in court. Gentile opened a beauty parlor and started bobbing girls' hair. Judge Perry

ruled the bobbing was a violation of the contract.

LONDON, May 19.—A woman burglar pleaded guilty to short sentence and pleaded that burglary was her means of supporting her child when convicted for the first time. She was sentenced to a penal servitude.
