

SKIS OF THE "JAZZ AGE" ARE AS FOOLISH AS YOUNGER ONES

Skirts, Bobbed Hair, Powder And Paint Belong To "Jazz Age" And Soon Will Pass Says Founder Of Christian Endeavor

CLAND, July 7. — (United Press) — The folks in this "jazz" age are as foolish as the younger generation, and more to be pitied than to be laughed at, Dr. Francis E. Clark, president emeritus of the Society of Christian Endeavor, said today.

His other engagements for the International Christian Endeavor convention Tuesday night to the "jazz" age of the doing of things, he said, will be to tell the younger generation that they are not as foolish as they think they are.

Dr. Clark said he was not alarmed over the younger generation. The whole mass is being consumed for what relatively a few sensational youngsters are doing.

In a great parade of Christian pageantry, more than 5,000 delegates to the International Christian Endeavor convention marched through the streets here Tuesday afternoon. It was the occasion for a victory of the Ohio delegation, which won the grand prize for display. The stunt showed representatives of all nations in a square of Ohioans, and signified that Ohio is seeking the International convention for Cleveland in 1927.

Dixie delegates won second prize for their marching and the Iowa crowd third for best general organization.

In general assembly the convention pledged itself by resolution to favor the world court as an agency of peace. Resolutions were unanimously passed urging congress to support "every effort that promises to bring about international limitation of armaments or that will create a spirit of friendliness among the nations of the earth."

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RGE DUVAL IS ANTE JUDGMENT

NEW YORK, July 7. — The owner of a mortgage on the farm of H. P. Galardi and Dorothy H. Galardi was granted a foreclosure judgment by circuit court yesterday. The judgment was for \$2,925 with interest at 6 per cent from the 11th of this year, and a flat sum of \$50 for attorney's fees and costs of the suit.

The court further decreed that the mortgage of the plaintiff was prior and paramount, and that the southeast quarter of section 1, township 46, south, range 1, west of the 100-acre tract, should be sold. The proceeds from the sale of the 100-acre tract will be applied on the cost of the suit, and on the plaintiff's judgment and attorney's fees.

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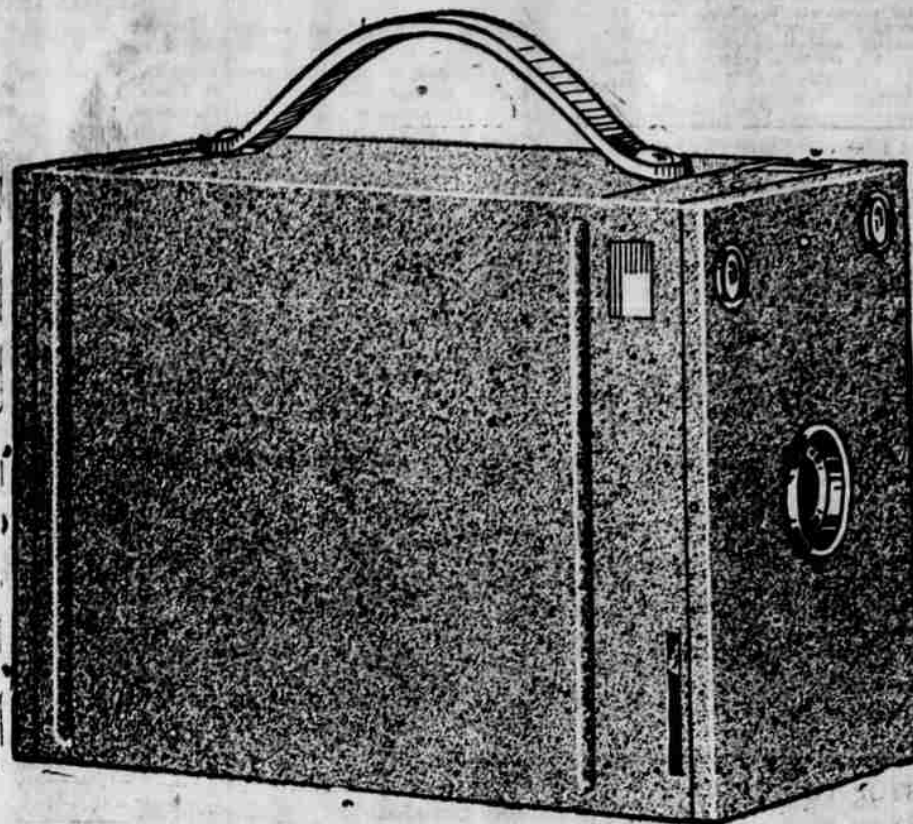
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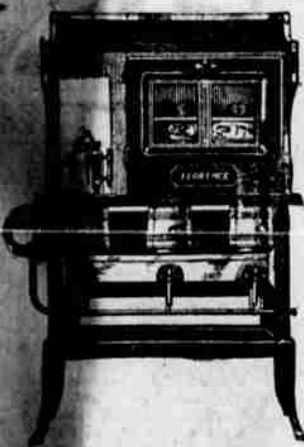
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
