"If you will be kind enough to rise and pick out your legs, I will take what remains," she said cheerfully.

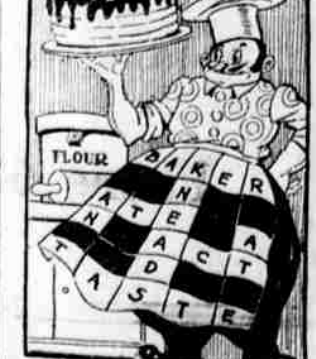
Children's Pictorial Cross Word Puzzle

TODAY'S RECIPES

Pancakes—Soak two cups of bread crumbs in two cups of sour milk over night. In morning thicken with equal parts white flour and corn meal, add a pinch of salt, a beaten egg and two teaspoons of soda dissolved in a little warm water. Beat very hard.

Elderberry Pie Filling—Two cups elderberries, one and one-half cups sugar, two tablespoons vinegar, one-third cup flour. Blend and put between two rich crusts.

Whole Wheat Bread—Four cups buttermilk, one cup brown sugar, a beaten egg, two rounded teaspoons soda, a scant teaspoon salt. Stir to a thick batter with whole wheat flour, making batter thick enough that it drops from a spoon.

Cobbler—Sweeten blackberries in pudding dish liberally and cover with rich biscuit dough. Bake in a medium oven.

Peach Ice Cream

One quart cream, three-fourths pound of sugar, quart ripe peaches. Put half the cream on to boil, when hot add sugar and stir until dissolved. Take from fire and add remaining cream. When cold freeze. Chop the peaches fine or mash them, add

to the frozen cream about five minutes, dasher and repack.
