

# PELICANS MOW DOWN THE TALL, UNGAINLY WEEK

## TYPICAL COAST LEAGUE GAME IS PELICAN VICTORY AFTER 10 HARD FOUGHT AND WELL PLAYED FRAMES

### Street Goes Full Route For Klamath And Hurls Finest Game Of Career; Both Sides Garner Only Nine Hits; Errors By Cremer Costly

It's unusual in a big league, to be true. But Sunday's game between Klamath Falls and Weed was as good as the best of Coast league baseball. Before the game the Pelicans frankly admitted they were going to win. The Weeds admitted it couldn't be done. And why? They had a streak of seven consecutive victories, two of them previous wins over Klamath Falls.

The Pelicans got out from the word go and played the finest exhibition of baseball in their long string of good ones. The game was fast and replete with sensational catches, squeeze plays and airtight pitching. That can be said for both teams. Had not Cremer, the Weed first baseman, gone to pieces in the tenth stanza and made two bad errors, the game would have been called on account of darkness.

It was hard to pick an individual star for the Pelican team. About the time one had his mind made up that so-and-so was the shining light, up would bob some other player with a bit of sensational stuff, and the idea would be spiked.

Street, however, pitched the finest ball game of his career. Only in one inning, the second, did he give way, and only then, when he had the Weed heavy artillery before him. He gave five hits in 10 innings, passed but one, and whiffed seven. Oeschger pitched a masterful game until he was relieved late in the sixth.

Here's a play by play account of how the Pelicans beat the Weeds:

Instead of holding up at third, Fuller was sent home, but he was nipped at the plate. Street rolled to the Weed pitcher, who tossed Mathews out, trying to make third. Apparently it was a hit and run play. Demitt rolled to Oeschger, and was

tossed out at first. One hit, no runs, no errors.

**Sixth Inning**

Anthony was sent in to hold the threatening Pelicans. Street cracked a hot one to short, who muffed it. Mathews scoring the tying run on the play, and Street was safe on first.
