Dead Dentist May Yet Be Tried For Murder

LOS ANGELES, Aug. 29.—The body of Dr. Thomas W. Young was enroute tonight to the home of his aged parents in Pittsburgh, Pa. Miss Isabelle Young, sister, who came here to testify at the dentist's trial, abruptly ended by his suicide, accompanied the remains.

The dramatic suicide of Dr. Young may not prove the ending after all of his trial for the murder of his young and beautiful wife.

The dead dentist's defender, John S. Cooper, announced he would fight to obtain a portion of Dr. Young's

\$80,000 estate, willed him by the slain woman for counsel fees. District Attorney Keyes said tonight if Cooper persisted in this, it might be necessary to try the dead man in civil court to determine whether he was guilty of murder.
