Plans for the library, which when... drawn up by the architect presented... an L-shaped building, were approv... ed by members of the library com... mittee and women's library board... and with several small alterations... were ready for the calling for the... bids.

It may be possible, according to... the committeemen, that bids will... be called for within the next ten... days. If so, work will be started... immediately and the excavation of... the property on the corner of Fifth... and Klamath avenue completed be... fore the first snow fall.

When finally completed, at an... approximate cost of \$40,000, the... library will have its entrance on... Fifth street. The land was a gift... from the estate of the late Hen... rietta Melhase.
