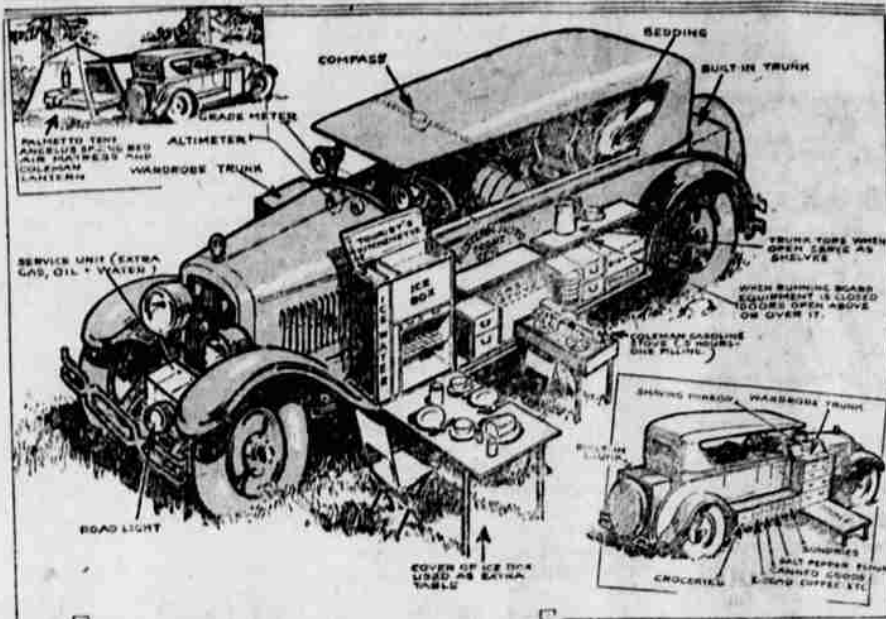


BLOCK PARTY PACT

Scout Car of Western Auto Attracts Interest of Local Residents for Whom It Works in Summer Time



One of the feature attractions at the formal opening of the Western Auto Supply company's new branch store in Klamath Falls, was the scout car and its pilot, "Outdoor" Franklin. It has every bit of equipment needed for such a car. From bumper to bumper and from side to side, it has been fitted for everything needed on a trip.

Starting at the front of the car, it is equipped with a heavy duty bumper. Between the guards, just behind the bumper a service unit is carried. This provides for a container for extra gasoline, oil and water. A road light is attached to the front spring. This provides a ray of light to be thrown across the road and about two feet off the ground, making night driving safe even in foggy weather.

The Merrill teams played their first games of soccer and volley ball today at Henley. Although they played good games, both teams were defeated.

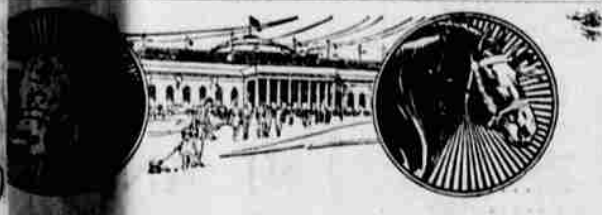
