NOTICE TO PROPERTY OWNERS WHOSE PROPERTY HAS BEEN FOUND LIABLE FOR THE COST OF IMPROVING JEFFERSON STREET FROM NINTH STREET EASTERLY TO THE UNITED STATES GOVERNMENT CANAL RIGHT OF WAY, EXCLUDING INTERSECTION AT TENTH STREET, KNOWN AS IMPROVEMENT UNIT NO. 41, THAT THEY HAVE TWENTY DAYS FROM THE FIRST PUBLICATION OF THIS NOTICE IN WHICH TO FILE APPLICATIONS TO PAY THEIR ASSESSMENTS IN TEN EQUAL ANNUAL INSTALLMENTS.

WHEREAS, the Common Council of the City of Klamath Falls, Oregon, did by Ordinance Number 706, duly adopted on the 13th day of October, 1925, declare the proportionate assessment on each lot, part of lot, block, parcel and acreage property found to be benefited for a proportionate share of the cost of improving Jefferson Street from Ninth Street easterly to the United States Government Canal Right of Way, excluding intersection at Tenth Street, known as Improvement Unit No. 41, all as more fully and in detail shown on the plans and specifications of the City Engineer on file with the Police Judge of said city in the matter of said improvement.

The property so found benefited and liable and assessed as aforesaid is all that property lying adjacent to said parts of said streets between the aforementioned terminal and extending back to the centers of the respective blocks so lying adjacent to said proposed improvement.
