NEW YORK, Nov. 4.—(United News)—Jimmy Slattery, Buffalo's light heavyweight contender, having pleaded that he is off form and in no condition to box in Syracuse next Friday, the New York boxing commission has given "Slats" 60 days of grace in which to get into shape to meet Yusuf Pearlstein.

The commission reinstated Frank Moody, Tommy Milligan and their manager, Billy Ames, on condition that Moody lives up to his contract to box for the Broadway club by November 23.

TRAINMEN WANT OLD TIME WAGES

Western Association to Ask That 12 Per Cent Be Restored to Pay

CHICAGO, Nov. 4.—(United News)—Representative of the Western Association of Trainmen and conductors in joint conference here have decided to demand that their wages be restored to "the war time" basis.

W. G. Lee, president of the trainmen announced Wednesday night that an "ultimatum" will be delivered to company officials next month when the present contract of the workers expires. Some of the roads he said, already have volunteered wage increases of five per cent.

During the world war railroad wages in this country reached their peak. After the war the United States railroad labor board ordered a 12 per cent cut in an attempt to bring the roads back to normalcy. The workers now have decided to demand that this amount be restored to their pay envelopes.
