

GRIDIRON CURFEW TOLLING IN EAST

NEW YORK, Nov. 23.—(United News)—The football curfew is tolling in the east, and fans look forward to the season's end.

Thanksgiving day and the following Saturday will find some of the leading teams of the east in action, but none of these can add appreciably to its prestige or upset the year's rankings by its performance.

The University of Pennsylvania and Cornell will meet at Philadelphia in a game that has become as much a Thanksgiving fixture as turkey, but both of these teams have been defeated in other games, which they regarded as of greater importance and a consolation prize is the best they can battle for.

Similarly with Columbia and Syracuse the game comes as an anti-climax, as the Lions and the Orange have sustained defeat at the hands of adversaries rated as more important than those they meet on Thursday.

And Saturday comes that ever-colorful encounter of the army and navy. Smarting under its defeat by Columbia, the army is "pointing" desperately for this game. It hopes to defeat the big navy team through superior kicking. Trappell and Hewitt were given long drills in this department.

SHEA AND McLARNIN TO FIGHT 12 ROUNDS

CHICAGO, Nov. 23.—Eddie Shea and Ed Mascanti, featherweights, will fight 12 rounds in Canton, Ohio, December 1, it was announced here Monday.

It will be Shea's second fight since he was knocked out by Phil Rosenberg, bantamweight champion, last fall. In the first fight, December 19, Shea knocked out Willie Ames, in two rounds.

Negotiations are under way to match Shea and McLarnin, the west coast whiz.

Shea fought Rosenberg as a bantam. After that fight he turned featherweight.

Sailor Friedman Gets Title Chance

NEWARK, N. J., Nov. 23.—Sailor Friedman of Philadelphia, who doesn't rate so very high in welterweight circles, but is a good rough and tumble battler, for all that, gets his chance at the 147 pound title, when he meets little Mickey Walker, the world's champion, in a 12 round bout at the Newark armory Wednesday night.

The sailor is game, but there is a feeling among the flatie fraternity that he isn't going anywhere. Walker, with Jack Kearns, dictating his appearances, obviously is not taking any great risk with his title. The bout probably be one of those affairs in which the champion takes a choice between popping his man off about the sixth round, or breezing on to win comfortably so points.

Mickey finished up his hard training Monday, working out on three sparring partners with eight ounce mittens. Patsy Rocco, Irish Tommy Jordan and Willie Coulter were on the receiving end of the champion's hooks and jabs which he rained in without restraint.

Walker will not have the advantage of Jack Kearns company in his corner Wednesday night, the champion's manager being in the west. But any suggestions that his absence will so hamper Mickey as to make Friedman a dangerous contender is considered as so much bally-hoo.

Friedman also has accepted his hard training and declared himself ready for the fight of his life, which is what Walker probably will give him.

The men will make the welterweight limit by Wednesday afternoon.
