Make Ready for East's Best Gridiron Heroes At S. F. on Dec. 26

SAN FRANCISCO, Dec. 16.—The all western football team which will oppose a squad of stars from the east in a charity game here on December 26, held its first practice Wednesday.

Imlay and Carlson of the University of California are the only two men who engaged in intercollegiate football during the 1925 season who will play in the benefit game.

The players who will appear in the various positions, as announced at the practice session are:

Guards: Buck Bailey of Olympic club; Jim Bryan, star of the 1913 Washington team, and Paul Minnick, formerly of Iowa and now of the U. S. C. coaching staff.
