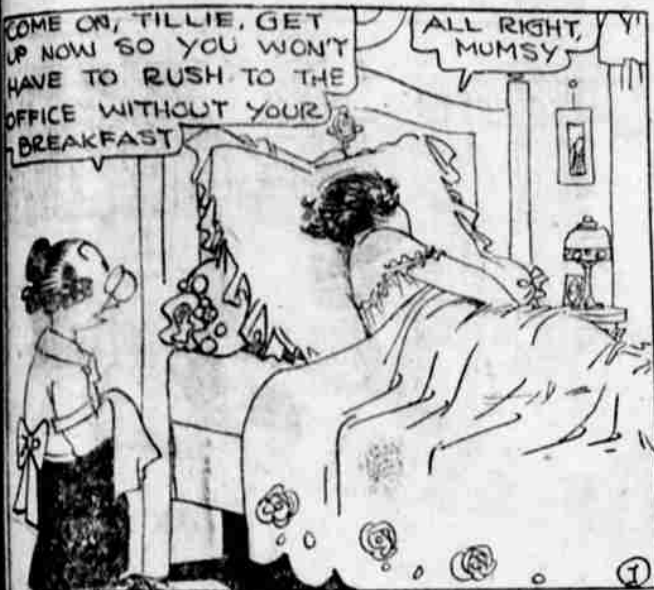

SURE I AM, TILLIE. SIT DOWN AND I'LL TELL YOU ALL ABOUT IT



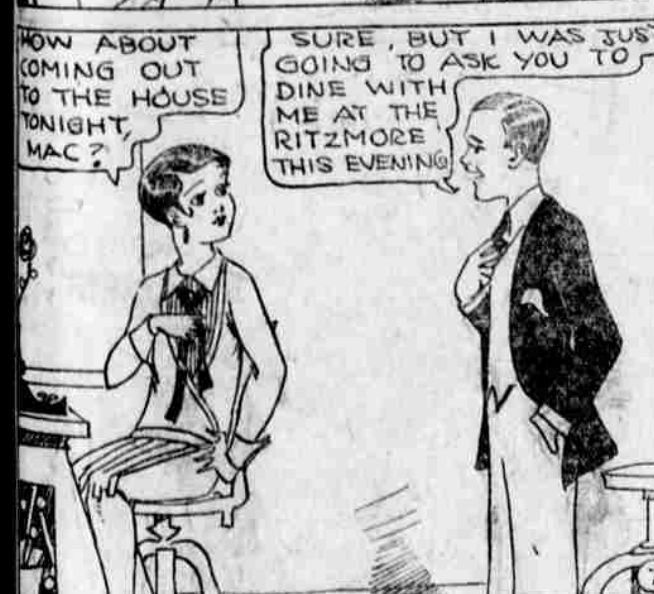
BUT YOU'RE GOOD LOOKING - IT'S REALLY SILLY TO TRY AND MAKE ME THINK YOU'RE MAC
