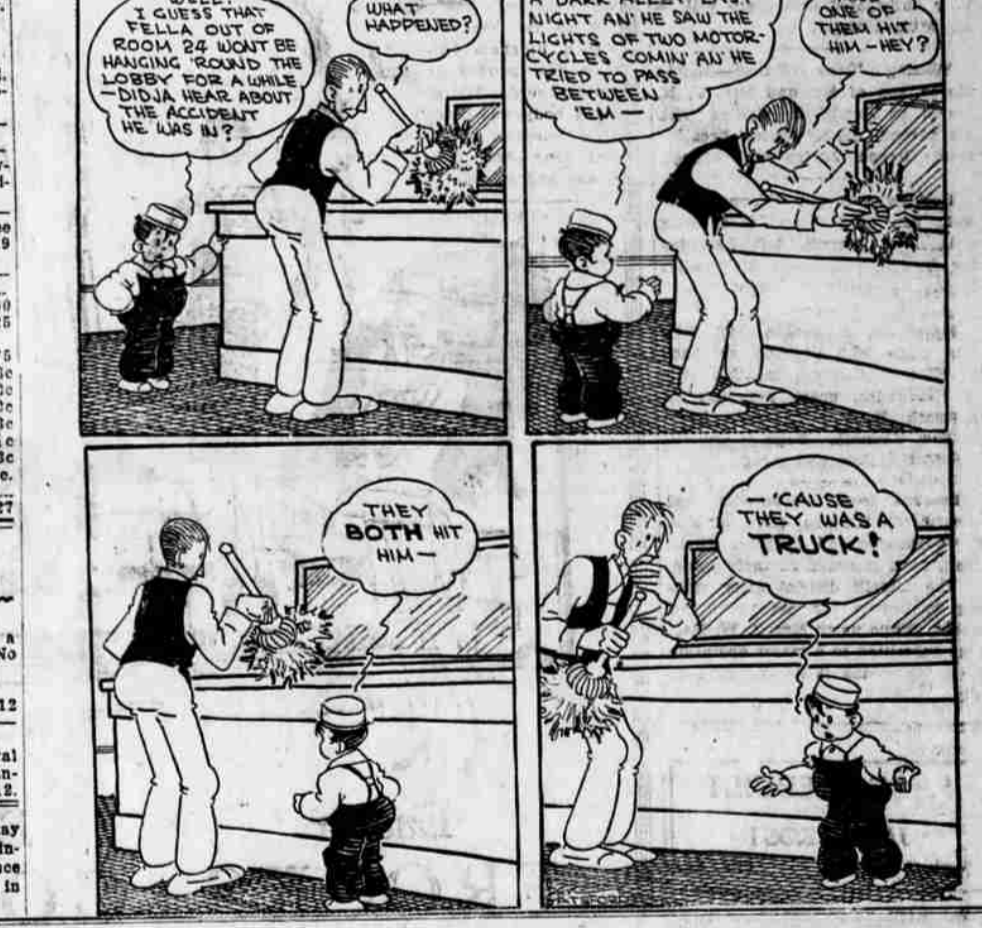
OLD PLAINSMAN DIES
