### Upholstery May Be Kept Clean

WASHINGTON, May 29.—Upholstering in your car can be cleaned. It should be refreshed at spring time and several times during the summer, when windows will be open and flying dirt. Soil creeps up on holsters to produce that sticky, greasy film that makes it impossible to get the car clean.

Water marks more often are in cloth lining of the top. Remove all floor coverings—to be dusted or washed, as you desire. Also take out all cushions and whip them with a carpet beater to loosen imbedded soil. Use your carpet cleaner to remove loose dirt—also brush stiffly with a wire brush. If possible use a vacuum cleaner to go over the interior of the car.

Disinfectant is necessary to remove stains after brushing with carbon tetrachloride, sponge the surface with cold water while it still contains carbon tetrachloride. While car interior is drying, leave all doors and windows open. During this period, gently brush the cloth upholstery to take the nap and dry it thoroughly.
