RESOLUTION OF INTENTION PINE STREET PAVEMENT

The City Engineer, pursuant to resolution of the Common Council heretofore adopted, having on the 19th day of July, 1926, filed plans, specifications and estimates of the cost of improving Pine street from the easterly line of Eleventh street to the westerly line of Esplanade, to be known as Improvement Unit Number 55, under advisement and finding said plans, specifications and estimates satisfactory:

BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED that said plans, specifications and estimates for the improvement of the said portion of said street, being the specifications and estimates attached herein on July 19th, 1926, be and the same are hereby approved; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Common Council hereby declares its intention to improve said portions of said street in accordance with said plans, specifications and estimates. Said improvement to consist of paving said portion of said street with (a) Warrenite bitulithic, 1 1/2" top on 3 1/2" bituminous concrete base, or asphaltic concrete, 1 1/2" top, 1" binder, on 3 1/2" asphaltic concrete base, or type "C" Portland cement concrete, or type "A" vibrolithic pavement; or (b) Warrenite bitulithic, 2" top on 4" bituminous concrete base, or asphaltic concrete, 2" top, 1" binder, 4" asphaltic concrete base, or type "A" Portland cement concrete, or type "A" vibrolithic pavement; or (c) Warrenite bitulithic, 2" top on 4" crushed rock base, or asphaltic concrete, 2" top, 1" binder, on 4" crushed rock base, at an estimated cost, including cement sidewalks, curbing, gutters and drainage for (a) Warrenite bitulithic, 1 1/2" top on 3 1/2" bituminous concrete base, or asphaltic concrete, 1 1/2" top, 1" binder, on 3 1/2" asphaltic concrete base, or type "C" Portland cement concrete, or type "A" vibrolithic pavement, of \$14,069.10; for (b) Warrenite bitulithic, 2" top on 4" bituminous concrete base, or asphaltic concrete, 2" top, 1" binder, 4" asphaltic concrete base, or type "A" Portland cement concrete, or type "A" vibrolithic pavement, of \$14,925.69; and for (c) Warrenite bitulithic, 2" top on 4" crushed rock base, or asphaltic concrete, 2" top, 1" binder, on 4" crushed rock base, of \$13,498.04; said estimates to include engineering, supervision, ad-

vertising, clerical assistance and unforeseen contingencies; said improvement to consist of grading the said street full width, constructing combination curbs and gutters, building five-foot cement sidewalks on either side of said improvement throughout its entire length, and providing drainage facilities for storm and sewage waters. Said pavement is to be forty (40) feet wide on that portion of said street lying westerly from the angle in said street, and thirty-eight (38) feet wide on that portion of said street lying easterly from said angle; all in accordance with the said plans, specifications and estimates filed July 19th, 1926; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL that the property hereinafter described be and hereby is declared to be benefited, to-wit:

Lots 5 to 11, inc., block 2; all block 3; and lots 1 to 19 inc., block 4. Second Hot Springs Addition to Klamath Falls, Oregon, together with the following described property: All that property lying between Eleventh and Pine streets, lot 5 of said block 3, and the line dividing lots 1 to 6, inc., on the one hand and lots 6 to 13, inc., on the other hand, of said block 3, extended in a straight line southwesterly to Eleventh street, parallel with Pine street to Eleventh street; and that said property above described be and hereby is declared to be benefited and assessed for the expense of said improvement; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Monday, the 30th day of August, 1926, at the hour of 8 o'clock p. m., at the Council Chambers in the City Hall of Klamath Falls, Oregon, be fixed as the time and place for the hearing of objections and remonstrances against said proposed improvement; and

The Police Judge be and he hereby is directed to cause notice of said hearing to be published as by charter provided.
