COME IN, FOLKS, GLAD YOU'RE EARLY...BISBEYS AND WALBACHS ARE COMING OVER TOO.



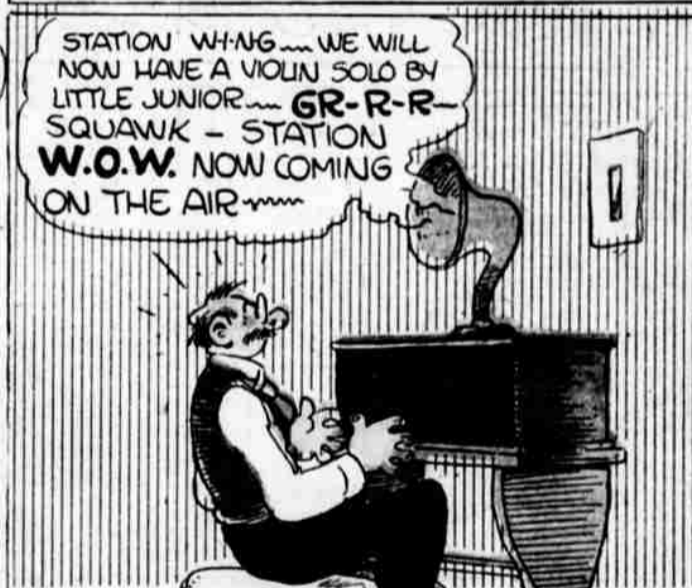

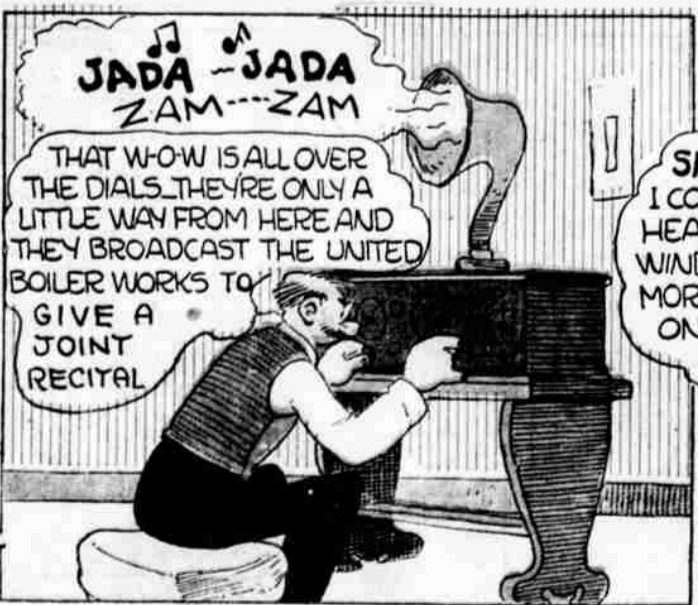
OH ISN'T THAT MARVELOUS... 'KISS ME AGAIN' I LOVE THAT.
