WASHINGTON, Nov. 11. ed News)—Corn production in the United States will be 2,693,963,-000 bushels, compared to a crop of 2,505,053,000 bushels in 1925, the agriculture department stated

The quality of the corn crop was forecast at 72.36 per cent of nor-mal. Corn yield per acre was placed at 26.7 bushels, compared with 28.6 bushels last year.
