FARMING ON HIGH IS POPULAR IN ARIZONA

ALPINE, Ariz., Nov. 24.—Alpine, with an elevation of about 9000 feet above sea level, is the highest point in Arizona where farming is the chief occupation of the inhabitants. Here the Blue Mashonok potato made its last stand in the United States, this variety ripening well in the short summers of the mountains. It has given place to standard varieties now. In the valley around Alpine, 1500 acres are cropped to corn, wheat, rye and oats, hull-less oats especially and returning large fields. There is plenty of rain during the summers, so irrigation is rarely needed.
