TAKE YOUR SON HUNTING

HARTFORD, Conn., Jan. 1.—The parent who has a hunting license is encouraged by the state game commission in its annual report to take his son or daughter with him when hunting and train them in use a gun, because they "should be encouraged to learn how to handle firearms."

The report points out that boys from ten to fifteen years old will learn how to handle and care for a gun more rapidly than parents who have never had any experience with firearms, and boys under sixteen may hunt lawfully on property which is owned by their parents. Boys whose parents do not own land in the country, or whose parents will not take them hunting, "are out of luck, if they have shooting inclinations," says the report.
