TAKE YOUR SON HUNTING

HARTFORD, Conn., Jan. 2.—The parent who has a hunting license is encouraged by the state game commission in its annual report to take his son or daughter with him when hunting and train them to use a gun, because they "should be encouraged to learn how to handle firearms."

The report points out that boys from ten to fifteen years old will learn how to handle and care for a gun more rapidly than persons who have never had any experience with firearms, and boys under sixteen may hunt lawfully on property which is owned by their parents. Boys whose parents do not own land in the country, or whose parents will not take them hunting, "are out of luck, if they have shooting inclinations," says the report.

P., three phase, 2200 volt motor, for cyclage of 60 to 61.5. Motor to be equipped with anti-friction bearings, starting-box and overload relay. This outfit to be designed to deliver water at two different heads—25 ft. and 55 ft. respectively.
