HERE'S A FRIENDLY TIP AS TO WHAT'S BEST IN WOODS

When in the woods it is best not to smoke or start a fire, but if you must, save your smoke until you can sit down by a creek and knock your ashes into the water. Build your camp fire in an open place or in the trail, or on a gravel bar. Build it where there is no fuel. It can spread to either on top of the ground or under the surface. An old root will burn for weeks and carry a fire for many feet. Never leave your camp fire unattended even for a few minutes. Every year campers do that, and some of them start forest fires and burn up their camp outfit as well.

In town there is no especial need for starting a conflagration. Cooking and heating are done by stoves; cigar butts are put into ash trays or thrown onto a concrete sidewalk or a watered lawn. In the woods there is no place to put a fire but on the ground that is covered, in most cases, with great quantities of dry fuel. It is just as easy to start a fire in the woods as it is to start a fire in a box of matches. So remember where you are and take no chances.

OLD POLKS TO GO TO THIS SCHOOL IN WALES

LONDON, May 30.—Establishment of the first residential college for adult education in Wales is made possible by the gift by a South Wales industrial leader of a large building located at Harlech. The building will furnish dormitory accommodations for thirty students. It has a good library, lecture rooms and dining hall, and an excellent music hall seating 300 persons, with a fine organ.

The governing body will be composed of representatives of different organizations in Wales interested in adult education, with Lord Haldane as the first president. Activities of the college will probably be limited at first to summer schools, short-term courses and institutes for tutors, or extension courses for adults, for which there is a growing demand.
