

### Dolp Eliminated in Golf Tourney

SEATTLE, July 22.—(U.P.)—Frank Dolp, Portland, western amateur golf champion, was eliminated in the third round of the annual western amateur golf association meet here today, by Fay Coleman of Los Angeles.

Dolp fought stubbornly throughout the 36 holes but fell behind on the ninth, his inability to get his putter to working spelled defeat for the champion.

Time and again chances to even the play appeared on the green. Dolp fell down in his putting.

Dr. O. F. Willing, Portland, eliminated H. Chandler Egan, Medford, one up. Von Stein, Seattle, defeated Harold Neimeyer, also of Seattle, 3 and 2.

Eddie Held, St. Louis, defeated Roy Moe, Portland, one up on the 41st hole after the most thrilling match of the day when first one then the other was ahead, and finally they seemed entangled in a hopeless tie.

Coleman will meet Stein and Willing against Held in the semi-finals tomorrow.

### SCIENTIST DESIGNS BED LIKE CRADLE

LONDON, July 22.—(A.P.)—The cradle idea of rocking an infant to sleep is to be applied to adults as well.

Sir Alfred Yarrow, British scientist, has constructed a bed which rocks the occupant to sleep.

Sir Alfred conceived the idea of his new invention while traveling. He found that when the train was in motion he was able to sleep better than when at rest. He then constructed his cradle-bed, which experiences 50 motions per minute, varying from three-eighths to three-quarters of an inch. Nausea is prevented by making the movements irregular.

### VEGETABLES

#### Baked Corn

- 1-4 cups evaporated milk
- 3-4 cup water
- 2 cups corn
- 2 eggs
- 1 tablespoon butter
- 1/2 teaspoon salt
- 1-5 teaspoon pepper

Combine the milk and water; add the butter and seasonings; bring to scalding point; add the corn and pour the mixture over the well beaten eggs. Pour into a well buttered baking dish, stand in a pan of hot water and bake in a moderate oven until firm in the center.

#### Stuffed Sweet Potatoes

- 6 medium sized, smooth sweet potatoes
- Salt and pepper to taste
- 2 tablespoons melted butter
- 1-3 cup evaporated milk
- Paprika

Wash the potatoes thoroughly and bake until tender. Cut in halves, lengthwise, and scoop out the inside. Mash and season to taste with salt and pepper. Add melted butter, lemon juice and evaporated milk. Beat well. Refill the potato skins, sprinkle with paprika, return to oven and brown lightly.

### Chicken Shortcake And Way to Make It

- 3 cups flour
- 3 teaspoons baking powder
- 1/2 teaspoon salt
- 1-4 cup butter
- 1/2 cup evaporated milk diluted with 1/2 cup of water.

Mix and sift dry ingredients. Rub in butter. Add gradually diluted milk. Divide in two parts on a floured board. Pat each into shape. Press one into pan and brush over with melted butter. Cover with second half and bake in hot oven about 25 minutes. Separate and fill with the following creamed chicken filling:

Make a cream sauce of these ingredients:

- 2 tablespoons butter
- 2 tablespoons flour
- 1 1/2 cups evaporated milk
- 1/2 cup water
- 1 tablespoon minced parsley
- 1 pimento, cut in strips
- 1/2 teaspoon salt
- Dash of paprika
- Pepper

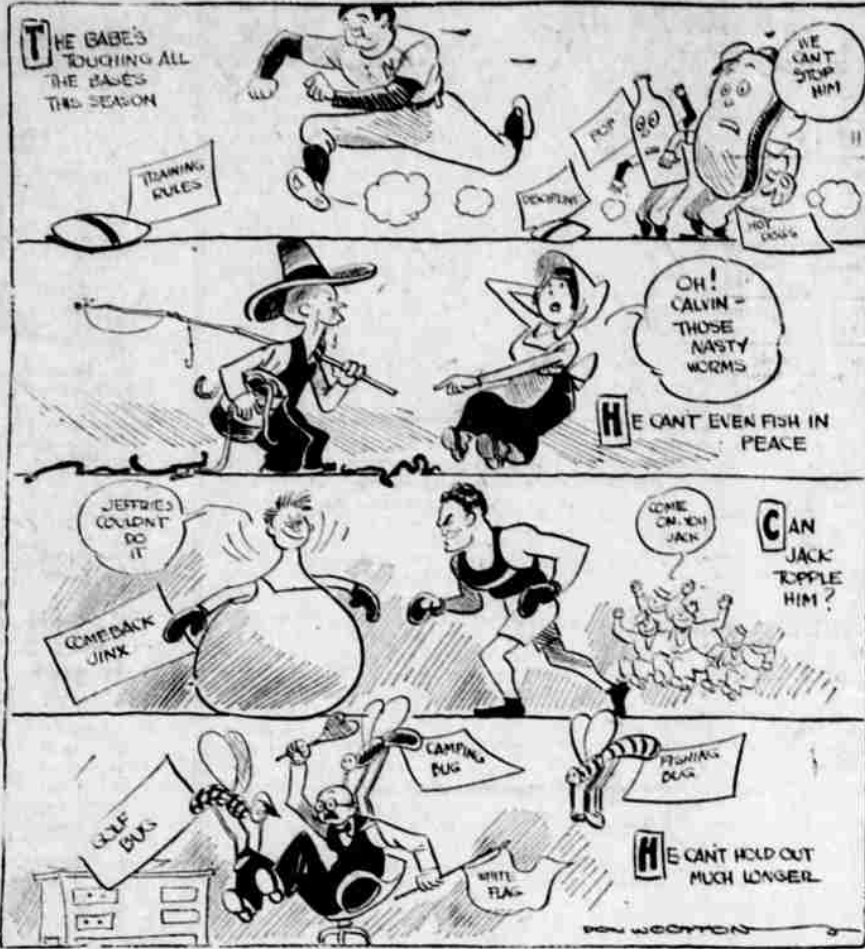
Heat in sauce two cups cold cooked chicken, diced. Let stand in double boiler one-half hour.

### RESOLUTION OF INTENTION

ALLEY IN BLOCK 49, NICHOLS ADDITION, BETWEEN NINTH AND ELEVENTH STREETS.

The City Engineer pursuant to a resolution of the Common Council heretofore adopted, having on the 11th day of July, 1927, filed plans, specifications and estimates of the cost of improving the alley in block 49, Nichols Addition to the City of Klamath Falls, Oregon, between Ninth and Eleventh streets, to be known as Improvement Unit No. 75, and the council having taken the same under advisement and having found said plans, specifications and estimates satisfactory:

BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED, that the Common Council hereby de-

clare its intention to improve said alley in accordance with said plans, specifications and estimates, said improvement to consist of paving said alley with (a) type "A" Warrenite bitulithic pavement, with 5" base, at an estimated cost of \$2,244.25, or (b) type "A" asphaltic concrete pavement, with 5" base at an estimated cost of \$2,129.16, or (c) cement concrete pavement 7" thick or vibrolithic pavement 7" thick at an estimated cost of \$2,259.25.

The above improvement in either event to consist of grading to the proper subgrade, constructing an appropriate hard surface pavement for the entire width of the alley (14 feet) by placing sewer connections where needed, and by performing all other work required to make a completed improvement, including alley stabs for the adjacent sidewalk spaces on Eleventh and Ninth streets.

The above improvement in either event to include engineering, supervision, advertising, clerical assistance and unforeseen contingencies, all in accordance with the plans, specifications and estimates on file with the Police Judge of Klamath Falls, Oregon.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Common Council that all of block 49 in Nichols Addition to the City of Klamath Falls, Oregon, be, and the same is hereby declared to be benefited and assessed for said improvement.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Monday, the 15th day of August, 1927, at the hour of eight o'clock P. M. at the council chambers in the City of Klamath Falls, be fixed as the time and place for the hearing of objections and remonstrances against said proposed

improvement. BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Police Judge, he, and he is hereby directed to cause notice of said hearing to be published as provided by the city charter, State of Oregon, County of Klamath, City of Klamath Falls.

### CATTLE BECOME WILD ON ALASKAN ISLAND

KODIAK, Alaska, July 22.—(A.P.)—Three hundred and fifty short-horn cattle browse over the mountainous surface of tiny Chilikof island, 200 miles out in the northern Pacific ocean from Kodiak.

More than 40 years ago the Alaska Commercial company, a development concern long since extinct, stocked the island with a few head of tame cattle for experimental purposes. On the little isle with a surface of but 20 square miles, the cattle have degenerated from inbreeding and have become thoroughly wild, but the herd continues to thrive. Alaskans say the experiment at least has proved that cattle can be grown in the region.



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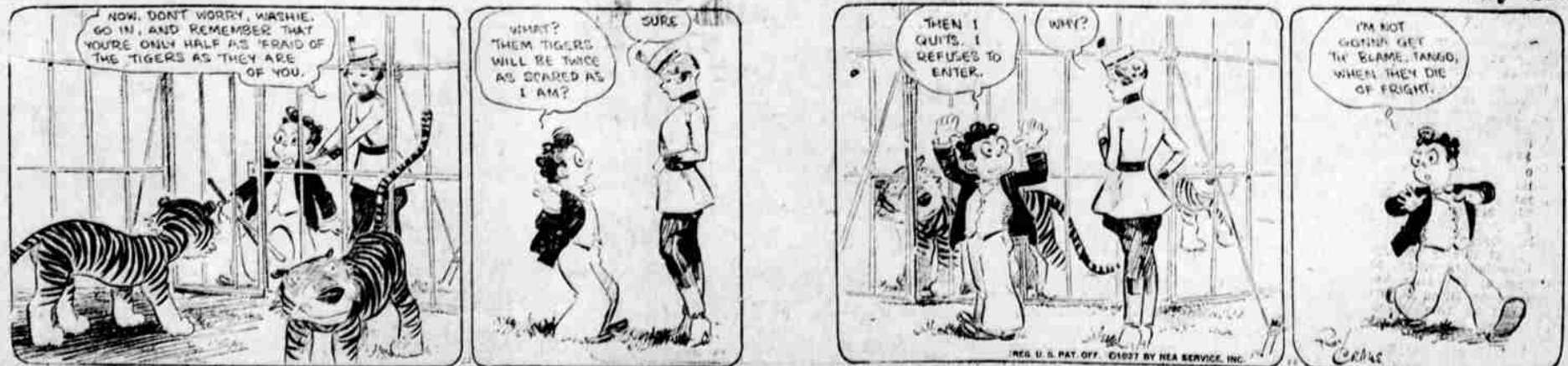
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
