Jake Opens Up On Champion In Billiard Game

NEW YORK, Dec. 20. (UP)—Playing brilliantly in contrast to his indifferent performance in the opening block, Jake Schaefer easily defeated Welker Cochran in the second block of their 1500 point world's championship billiard match today.

Schaefer required only four innings to reel off 288 points, missing a difficult two cushion shot only to return to the table a moment later to finish the block with an unfinished run of two for his fifth inning.

Cochran again was in poor form, and now trails Schaefer by 184 points, the score at the end of the afternoon block standing Schaefer 600, Cochran 416.

In his third inning of the afternoon, "Young Jake" elicited a high run of 135, the best of the match to that point.

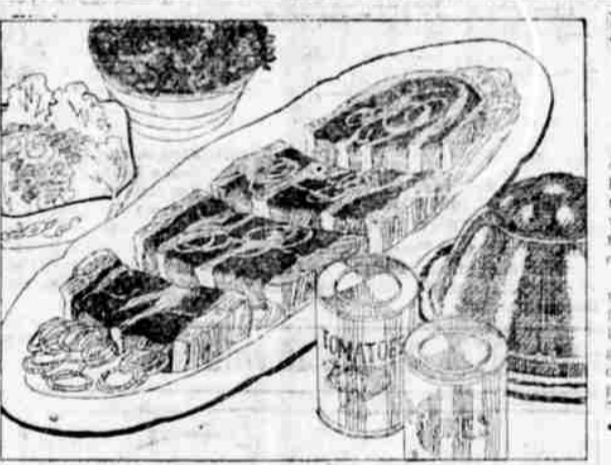
Garnishes Lend Attractiveness To Dish of Meat

FISH DINNERS

Any fish is the better for a bit of fresh watercrust as a garnish and usually the flavor of tomatoes is a welcome one in a fish dinner. The following simple menus have been planned to show four different methods of cooking fish. The salmon steaks may be pan broiled or broiled on a broiler under the flame. Ribbon Stamp On Beef Is Boon To Housewives

Can the housewife pick out a choice piece of meat at the market? Statistics show that she can not. At least the majority of women are unable to. They have to rely on the man behind the counter.
This lack of knowledge of meat quality was one of the principal factors taken into consideration in the inauguration of a new government service whereby beef of the two top grades, known as prime and choice, is now plainly

labeled as such by means of a rubber stamp. The stamp is of the roller design, thus making a continuous ribbon mark which appears on most of the retail cuts.
Stamp Is Guarantee
This mark is a guarantee to the purchaser that the meat is of a particular quality. It may be either "U. S. Prime Beef," "U. S. Choice Beef," "U. S. Prime Ham," or "U. S. Choice Ham." It should not be confused with the federal inspection stamp which is of round design and indicates that the meat was inspected at the time of slaughter and found healthful for human consumption.
The housewife who feels some uncertainty as to whether the meat she buys will measure up to expectations when it is set before the family should find the new government label a real comfort. She can rest assured that if the meat she buys bears the ribbon stamp it is exactly what it is claimed to be.
