Kidwell Admits He Knew Sleuths Were On Trial

WASHINGTON, Dec. 20. (AP)—Playing a trump card, the government today obtained from Edward J. Kidwell, a juror in the Fall-Sinclair contempt case, a statement he was aware that he was being shadowed by detectives during the trial.

The testimony was considered important inasmuch as the defense has claimed that no contempt of court could have been committed so long as no juror knew he was being placed under surveillance.

Kidwell is the man accused of having boasted of gains he expected from a verdict in the trial of Harry F. Sinclair and Albert B. Fall.

Called as a government witness today he identified two Burns detectives as those who followed him.

The witness said John Klime, one of the detectives, approached him in a near beer saloon, and the other, Dan Merritt, had followed him from the court house, boarding the same street car.

This testimony was the first to show any member of the conspiracy juror was aware of surveillance being made by Burns detectives, employed by Sinclair.

Markets

PORTLAND, Ore., Dec. 20. (A. P.)—Conditions on the local wholesale poultry markets are little changed today with the undertone in all divisions weak.

Turkey receipts late yesterday and early today were heavy with few buyers in the market but prices held mostly around 37c and 38c for best quality birds on small trading. Geese are in plentiful supply around 26@30c.

Dairy exchange quotations on butter and eggs are steady. Country dressed meats are likewise steady with demand slightly increased.

On the wholesale fruit and produce markets trading is considerably heavier. Cranberries are higher; best eastern berries moving in good volume between the 20 and 22 per 100 lb. barrel. Coast cranberries are scarce and are in demand at \$5.75 to \$6.00 per 1-3 barrel box.

Seasonal nuts are moving in large volume and supplies of Brazils and Filberts are about cleaned up. The former are quoted around 26c, while the latter are bringing from 25c to 30c.
