Progress Is Made On Road Projects

Rapid progress in the surfacing of the Beatty-Fremont Forest boundary section of the Klamath Falls-Lakeview highway is being made by the Spokane contracting firm of W. C. Egan and Greeno, according to word received here yesterday.

Six miles of base course has been laid and as high as 650 yards of gravel has been laid in one day. The operation is now between Beatty and Bly.

Progress is also reported in the grading of the Devil's Garden section of the Klamath Falls-Lakeview highway. W. C. Egan has the contract. The project will be completed in the fall.

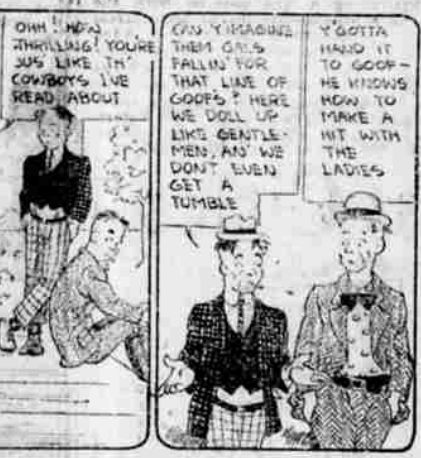
