vacation of a portion of a street
in the City of Klamath Falls,
Klamath County, State of Ore-
gon, as follows, to-wit:

Beginning at the southeasterly
corner of lot 1, block 10, In-
dustrial Addition, where the water-
line of E. Dezaedo avenue in-
tersects the northerly line of Oak
avenue; thence S. 85 deg. 02',
24" W. along the northerly line of
Oak avenue, a distance of
128.91 feet to a point on the
easterly right-of-way line of the
Central Pacific Railway company,
