RADIOS INSTALLED FOR STATE PATROL

"The Klamath department is very grateful to receive the short wave sets," Sergeant Davis said. "We feel the equipment will be of great benefit to us as well as residents of the city and county because of the co-operation promised from the city police department radio station." The city police radio station has been operating on a day and night schedule since last week. Clifford Smith and Everett Power, both licensed radio operators, are employed for full shifts and permitting the station to be idle for only a few hours each day.

SUMMER CLASS WORK ANNOUNCED

The annual 4-H club summer school will open at Corvallis at Oregon State college on June 12, lasting two weeks, when special courses will be given as usual for 4-H club members.

Any 4-H club boy or girl over 12 years of age is eligible to attend, providing they have had at least two years of 4-H club work in Klamath county. There will be no county funds available this year for expenses, and any boy or girl desiring to go must pay for his or her own expenses, including railroad fare, board and room. If anyone is interested in going they should get in touch with the county club agent and further information regarding summer school can be secured by calling the club agent's office.
