"And when your doctor warns you to take especial care in the

selection of milk he speaks with the memory of epidemic and disease in the back of his mind, resulting from impure milk." Mr. Woodruff says. "Just as oranges, and other fruits and vegetables need to be washed and cleaned before eating, because they cannot be handled without picking up harmful germs; and just as the utensils for preparing and bottling baby's food are so carefully sterilized before using, so must milk be given that same consideration. Milk as a liquid will harbor and culture more germs than a dry material, and its very richness in food material makes it more readily susceptible to contamination.

**Milk Made Safe**  
"It is then, not only the better part of discretion, but a very logical program, to make milk, the contents, as safe and free from harmful germs as the receptacles which are used to contain it.

"Pasteurization is the process used for making milk safe. All inspected dairies produce milk under the most hygienic conditions for their methods; but investigation proves that only by pasteurization can infant mortality be lessened, and epidemics, cholera and dysentery be checked most efficiently.

"Public health is now recognized as a public responsibility.

**Toll Once Heavy**  
"We all remember the time when such terrible toll was taken among our babies during each summer. Dysentery and cholera, infantum brought its terrible scourge into every community, and babies died in spite of all that could be done for them. Some of this tragedy was due to unsanitary living conditions, but most of it was caused directly from contaminated milk. Most of these babies were being fed on raw milk. Mothers did not know that all milk must be sterilized before it is safe to use. It is due to pasteurization that our babies now have a fair chance to survive their infancy."

SALEM, June 7 (AP)—Pearl Devore, 62, hanged herself with a belt obtained from another patient at the State hospital yesterday.

Attendants said several other attempts to take her own life had been made since her commitment from Eugene February 28 of this year. The body will be sent to Eugene where relatives live.

## PLANS STUDIED TO REDUCE TAXES

ALTURAS, Calif.—The Taxpayers league of this city with J. T. Negley as chairman and W. B. Williams as secretary, after months of study of the local situation, presented to the city council plans for reduction in city taxes.

Among the plans was a recommendation of refinancing the various bond issues by a heavy reduction in the capital amounts of the bonds. Another drastic recommendation of the organization was that the city's electric power bill be cut in half. Power for lights and the city's pumping and sewer plant is supplied by the California Service company.

Recommendations were also made for a reduction in salary of all city officials and an entire budget was presented by the league covering all city expenses.
