

BIG CARAVAN WILL TRAVEL TO OPENING

A caravan of cars, en route to the official opening of Crater Lake national park Saturday, will leave Klamath Falls shortly before noon, motor to Fort Klamath for lunch and continue to the lake, according to plans announced at the junior chamber of commerce dinner and meeting at the Willard hotel Monday evening.

The junior chamber is sponsoring the official opening day and has arranged an elaborate program at the lake for visitors expected from various sections of Oregon and California.

The trail to the water from the lodge will be opened and visitors will be afforded free housing and fishing through the courtesy of arrangements made by the junior organization. In the evening an entertainment will be sponsored at the lodge by Richard Price, manager, and the junior chamber.

All meals at the lake during the opening day will be cut to a 50 cent charge.

A board of directors for the recently organized junior chamber of commerce was elected Monday evening. In addition to the officers who will serve as members, Martin Swanson, Keva Hutchinson, William Kuykendall and Orth Slesmore were elected.

The board is composed of eight members including officers: John Hawkins, president; Joe Evans, vice president; Rudy Jacobs, secretary; Bill Owsley, treasurer.

A regular monthly dinner meeting was set for the first Tuesday of each month. The meetings will be open to anyone interested in the work of the organization.

The first meeting of the directors, with whom R. C. Groenbeck, senior chamber of commerce director, representative, will meet, will be held at the chamber of commerce Thursday evening.

Dues for the organization were placed at \$6 per year, payable quarterly in advance. The charter membership roll will be open until July 1, according to Secretary Jacobs.

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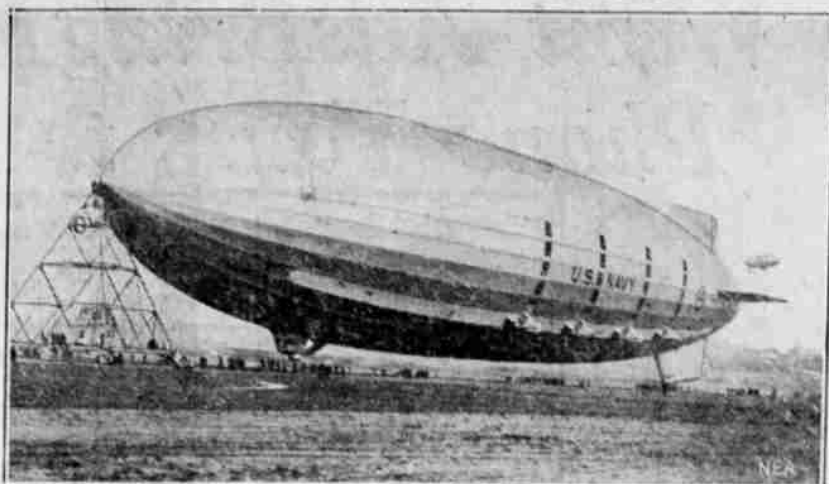
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As Macon Got First Taste of Air

The state weather bureau forecast included mountain thunderstorms, considerable cloudiness, little change in temperature and coastal fogs.

Bail Forfeited On Liquor Count

Fred Haynes, charged with possession of liquor, forfeited \$50 bail Tuesday morning when he failed to appear in police court to answer to the count. He was arrested Monday night.

Hearings for C. L. Thornhill, charged with possession of liquor and drunk and disorderly conduct, and Robert Galloway, drunk and disorderly, were scheduled for Tuesday afternoon in police court. Galloway posted \$10 bail for his appearance.

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DEADLINE FRIDAY ON AUTO LICENSE

Car owners driving on city or county roads without new license plates or temporary stickers after Friday evening may be subject to arrest, according to information received Tuesday morning.

Sergeant R. D. Davis of the state police office declared he had received no instruction from the Salem headquarters concerning a grace period after the deadline date, July 1. If no instructions are received, the officers will be required to enforce the law when it becomes effective, he stated.

Approximately 400 temporary license stickers showing the regular plates have been applied for, have been issued from the county tax collector's office the past week. The largest issue was Monday when 127 licenses were applied for and temporary permits issued.

Car owners are not required to make application from the local tax office. If the owner holds the receipt of registration issued when the last plates were sent, new plates may be obtained by filling out the back side of the slip and sending it to the secretary of state's office with the required fee.

New or foreign car owners who have not received the registration receipt may apply through

the tax collector's office where the necessary blanks are furnished.

Those desiring a temporary permit to operate until the new plates are received may obtain them for 25 cents at the tax office. The temporary permit will not be issued unless the license have been applied for.

DECREASE SHOWN IN TYPHOID CASES

SALEM, Ore. (AP)—A measure of the intelligence of the people of the state is the number of cases of typhoid fever, a preventable disease, says the state health board.

In Oregon, there has been a marked decrease in the disease during the last several years, but 124 cases and 14 deaths last year are held by the health officials to be a severe indictment of the intelligence of Oregonians. In 1928, there were 189 cases of typhoid, 27 deaths in the state, worst record of recent years.

Protection of milk and water supplies is the principal precaution to prevent spread of typhoid fever, the health experts say. The disease is spread almost entirely through food and water, although it is also carried by flies, soiled clothing, or direct contact.

Bull Fight For Molalla Causes Wide Comment

SALEM, June 27 (AP)—Governor Julius L. Meier is receiving letters from all parts of the country protesting a bull fight which was talked for the Molalla Buckaroo July 2, 3 and 4, but abandoned 10 days ago.

This morning 375 letters of protest were received at the executive office—largely from humane society members in numerous states.
