

OREGON DEAN DEMANDS KERR RESIGN POST

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C. Nelson resignation will be made Saturday at a meeting of other board members.

All will be here Saturday for the Oregon-Oregon State football game. It is believed they will hold an informal discussion to determine what steps to take in ironing out present difficulties.

Next regular meeting of the board is scheduled for December.

PORTLAND, Nov. 9. (AP) — Governor Meier said today he has not yet decided when he will appoint a successor to Roscoe C. Nelson on the board of higher education. He gave no indication who he might be considering for the post.

PORTLAND, Ore., Nov. 9. (AP) —The resignation of the president of the board of higher education, and the demand by a University of Oregon spokesman that Chancellor W. J. Kerr resign, today had left higher educational administration in this state in a condition as unsettled and strained as at any time in the past four hectic years.

Roscoe C. Nelson, president of the board, late yesterday submitted his resignation, which was accepted by Governor Meier who declared "I have followed the events of the past week with the deepest interest and I am impelled to say that your courage and convictions have vindicated completely my choice in placing you upon the board."

At the same time Wayne L. Morse, dean of the university school of law, called for the resignation of Chancellor Kerr.

"Intellectual honesty," Dean Morse declared, "compels me to call the attention of the state to the undeniable fact that harmony in higher education is impossible until a chancellor is appointed who is free from long-standing partisanship in educational controversies."

In accepting the board president's resignation, Governor Meier said he did so only "because my knowledge of the facts as to the condition of your health convinces me that your continuance under existing circumstances would involve too great a drain upon your physical resources."

Controversy Serious. "Upon that condition alone," the governor stated, "do I reluctantly accede to your request."

Nelson had made no mention of his health, although friends had remarked on that phase of the situation.

The bitter battle surrounding the Nelson regime and the Kerr administration flared into fury last Saturday when Dean Morse made an attack on President Nelson for two addresses Nelson had made a few days before on the Eugene and Corvallis campuses.

Fire Used in Farm Strike Of Midwest

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Wis., and an attempt made to dynamite a barn near Waukesha, in the same state.

At the same time non-striking farmers in at least four Iowa counties, and dairymen in various parts of Wisconsin, were banding together in hundreds to carry their produce to market. Their leaders said they would "fight violence with violence."

Pickets Disband. In Illinois, where strike activity appeared only in the last few days, 75 elevators were closed at the request of a committee of strike sympathizers. State high-

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way police conveyed milk and livestock trucks to Kankakee, although no violence was reported.

New price contracts were negotiated between dairymen and distributors in the Green Bay and Twin Cities districts of Wisconsin and Minnesota. Both communities have been suffering from a serious shortage of milk.

Pickets had disappeared in the tri state area of Iowa, South Dakota and Nebraska. Law enforcement officials were particularly active in that district. Cold weather was believed to have played a part in recession of activities.

SIoux CITY, Ia., Nov. 9. (AP) —Truckloads of cattle, hogs and sheep were on their way to Sioux City today, signaling the apparent end of farm strike picketing in this territory.

Truck drivers who had been idle for more than a week because of the blockades, sped over the highways without fear that their cargoes might be halted and unloaded.

No Trouble Encountered. Sheriff William twice took a precautionary measure by delegating deputies to serve as escorts for trucks entering the city but no trouble was encountered.

Farmers in Plymouth county, scene of violence on several occasions since the threatened hanging of a district court judge last spring, yesterday organized a law and order league with the intention of forcibly clearing the highways if the pickets remained on duty.

Another railroad bridge—the third since the "war" for higher prices started—was destroyed by fire early today. The bridge, the property of the Chicago, Milwaukee, St. Paul & Pacific, was situated a mile south of Portsmouth.

Sheriff George E. Jensen of Shelby county said he found evidences of kerosene and other combustible materials on the burning structure, and blamed farm strikers.

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
