Above is a photograph of the new and enlarged structure occupied by Moty and Van Dyke, Inc., at the corner of Klamath avenue at Seventh. The building is two and a half times as large as it was before the addition was built, and now is able to take care of the vastly increased business of the Klamath country. In the basement will be kept additional stock to completely fill the needs of this territory for shop equipment, industrial supplies, tools, auto and tractor parts, etc. Charles D. Withers was general contractor on the job.

## Klamath Business Increases Space With Handsome Addition

Responding to the demands of increasing business, MOTY AND VAN DYKE, Inc., have expanded their auto accessory and parts house at Seventh street and Klamath avenue into a spacious and handsome new addition, and now boast one of the finest establishments of the kind in any smaller city of the Pacific coast.

The addition was made on the west side of the older structure, which occupies the southwest corner of the intersection, a key business center of the city.

Floor space is increased one and one-half times as a result of the expansion. Frontage on Klamath avenue is extended from 40 feet to 104 feet.

Originally, MOTY AND VAN DYKE used a basement 40x50 feet in size. Their basement is now 64x104 feet, materially increasing storage space so that the firm can keep on hand an enormous stock with which to meet even the unusual needs of the accessory and parts buying public.

The company carries shop equipment, industrial supplies, tools, auto, tractor parts, etc.

The building is of concrete and tile construction. The Klamath avenue front has an attractive concrete finish, with the name of the firm mounted across the face of the structure in large, modern-style lettering.

MOTY AND VAN DYKE is a home-owned business. It has 16 employees, two of whom were added after the recent enlargement. The proprietors of this modern business are Harry E. Van Dyke and Kasper M. Moty.

The firm also has opened two branches, one in Alturas and the other in Lakeview.
