

STUNT AVIATRIX USES SMOKE TO TRACE COURSES

Daring aerobatics close to the ground, with a wide variety of difficult maneuvers, will be presented by Bernadine Lewis King, world's champion woman stunt flier, in the "Sky Circus" program of the 1937 Oregon Air Tour in Klamath Falls, July 3, to be held as the opening feature of the Buckaroo Days celebration. Announcement of the signing of the champion woman stunt flier as a featured performer on the "Sky Circus" program was made by Allan D. Greenwood, tour director.

With the addition of Miss King as the featured woman flier, the tour program now has the two top-ranked stunt fliers of both sexes. Since Tex Rankin, world's champion man stunt flier, has already been signed as a "Sky Circus" star.

Flying her own specially built stunt ship, Miss King will give the most thrilling exhibition of stunt flying ever presented by a woman in the Pacific Northwest. She performs many maneuvers which only a few men stunt pilots can do. She is a transport airplane and seaplane pilot, with more than 700 hours to her credit. She will enter two ships in the air tour, one of which will be flown by her husband.

A beautiful and thrilling accomplishment to her stunting exhibition will be the use of smoke, pouring out of her ship in a dazzling white trail. She laces the sky with an intricate pattern of smoke, massive curlicues and figures hundreds of feet high.

As the only woman sky writer, Miss King is unique. She can write easily in smoke with letters several hundred feet high, despite the difficulty of maneuvering her airplane so that the letters are correctly formed.

Upside-down flying is Miss King's specialty and she holds the upside-down flying record for women, with a spectacular upside-down flight from Agua Caliente to Los Angeles.

"I absolutely guarantee to fly longer upside down than any other pilot at the show!" said Miss King in outlining her performance.

At several score shows Miss King has thrilled thousands of spectators. She has brought her act down to the ground where the maneuvers can be clearly seen by spectators. Here are some of the stunts which she will perform:

1. Steep take-off and climb to 1500 feet.
2. Consecutive loops with smoke, huge circles cut in the sky.
3. Smoke vertical with loop through, forming a lace-like chain of smoke across the sky.
4. Smoke rings.
5. Consecutive Immelman turns.
6. Consecutive snap rolls.
7. Triple vertical reversal ending in a snap.
8. Regular reversal.
9. Wing-over.
10. Slow roll over runway close to the ground.
11. Half-roll.
12. Thrilling upside-down flight over the field.
13. Half-roll with 180 degree turn.
14. Half-roll inverted with a complete 360 degree turn around field at 500 feet.
15. Half-roll out of the turn with a 180 degree turn.
16. Roll with an inverted dive to 500 feet.
17. Falling leaf to 50 feet of the ground.
18. Loop, finishing at 50 feet.
19. One wheel landing.
20. Picking handkerchief with strut or wing tip.

The outstanding woman stunt pilot of the United States, Bernadine Lewis King, will be one of the featured ace performers on the "Sky Circus" program of the 1937 Oregon Air Tour, which will be presented in ten cities in Oregon.

Her thrilling performance is part of the three-hour program of thrills and speed. It will include many stunts never before presented by a woman flier in the Pacific Northwest. She will use smoke in her stunting exhibition to gain spectacular effects.

Those planning to enter the parade are advised to be on the corner of Second and Klamath avenue at 10:30 o'clock Monday morning. The parade will proceed down Second street to Main street, turning right at the Willard hotel corner and going the length of Main street, ending in

front of the Big Basin Lumber company.

This will also be the line of march for the cowboy parades of Saturday and Sunday.

An invitation is issued to all individuals, firms, organizations and civic groups to take part in the parade, according to Finley.

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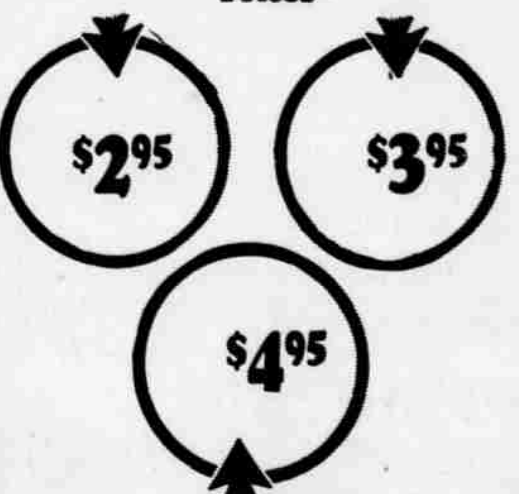
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
