

STOCK FEATURE OF LAKEVIEW ROUNDUP

LAKEVIEW, Ore.—Little more than fifty years ago one of the greatest horses in the history of racing was produced from the strings of the Foster ranch in Lake county, Oregon. Today these racers are no more, but their descendants and relatives may be seen in every aspect of the Eighteenth Annual Lakeview Roundup to be held in Lakeview Saturday, Sunday and Monday, September 4, 5 and 6.

"Oregon Eclipse" will be remembered in the minds of many older enthusiasts of the sport of

kings as the most unusual racer of all time. He couldn't be handicapped by weight; he started as a two-year-old and never lost a race and had the unique record of breaking a record, whether that of an opponent or his own, in every race he entered.

Sold when five years old in San Francisco he died from a cold contracted on the boat on the way to Portland. The story is told that within a few hours after his death there wasn't a hair left on his mane or tail. Souvenir collectors had taken their toll.

Information regarding this famous horse was secured from Mrs. Lula Schminck, of Lakeview, and her brother, John Foster, two of the remaining members of the large family of horse lovers. Among the few of his records that could be delved from memory was that of 1 mile in 1 minute, 13 sec-

onds. He was not particular as to distance and he ran in any race from 1 to 14 miles.
