

REPORT MADE ON SALVATION ARMY CONFAB

Recently, Mrs. Mae K. Short and the writer attended a conference of Salvation Army Advisory Board Members of Oregon and Southern Idaho held in Portland. We were introduced to Major Ronald Eberhart, our host for the day. Major Eberhart formally introduced each member of his staff to the group assembled. We were shown through the citadel offices where most of the business of the Salvation Army is carried on in Portland. These offices are as convenient and as efficiently handled as the offices of any city in the state. Here at this time, Major Eberhart gave reports on the various activities of Salvation Army work. We were amazed at the size of the gymnasium in this building where clubs of boys are instructed by competent officers.

A reception room is open each day where mothers of families gather and are taught domestic science, all gratis. They are instructed in sewing, cooking and budgeting their small family incomes. Here they have the use of sewing machines and other equipment not found in their own homes. These women also enjoy the companionship of those in attendance and are given courage and help through these contacts. Many lasting friendships have been made this way. This group functions practically the same as a women's club in any community.

We were taken from the citadel to the Men's Industrial home where we saw the actual work carried on in this institution to rehabilitate the men and material that come to it. A store is maintained where all materials are sorted, cleaned and repaired before they are placed on sale to the public. Everything given them is utilized from furniture to old papers, magazines and rags. The men employed in this institution are paid standard wages from the returns from the store. No outside money is used. Brig. Heinsinger is the officer in charge. In this home are dormitories, a chapel, recreation hall, dining-rooms and kitchen, all used exclusively for transient men. Here, each man has his work to do. No man is fed or given help unless he works if physically fit; which is the proper way to retain his self-respect.

Here, we met a charming old southern gentleman who for the past few years has made his home with the Salvation Army. We were told that not many years ago he was one of Portland's well-known active citizens, reduced financially to these circumstances as a result of the depression. He is very happy and grateful for the home given to him. This is only one example of the many worthy cases cared for here by the Army. Brig. Heinsinger, in a short interesting talk, gave the group a full report of the home's receipts and disbursements for the past year. The total receipts for the store were \$5487.

This report gave me the thought that one must never destroy anything no matter how valueless it may seem at the time. The Salvation Army can always use it to great advantage for the good of suffering humanity.

We were entertained at luncheon at the Salvation Army White Shield home which serves the entire state of Oregon. This home is a beautiful large house with wide verandas set on spacious grounds. It formerly was the home of one of Portland's wealthy pioneer families. The beauty and stability of the home are paralleled by the unselfishness of the staff of officers in charge. In this building are cared for, delinquent girls sent by the courts and about 45 unmarried mothers with babies. They have modern hospital facilities which would be a credit to any city. Portland doctors give their services.

The first meeting of the First Aid class was held at the Fairview school Wednesday evening. These meetings will be held weekly until the course is completed. The group that is enrolled in this class really means business and is getting down to brass tacks right off the bat. It wouldn't surprise us if we had a whole flock of well qualified first-aid men about town before many moons.

Incidentally the American Red Cross is offering something new that will be of interest to public utility companies, fleet operators and the like who wish to cooperate in the matter of emergency first aid on the highways. This is in the organization of Mobile Emergency First Aid Units. The first step in qualifying for a unit is in seeing that the truck operators and/or helpers are certified as first-aid men. When this is done and other requirements are met certain recognitions are given to the company so cooperating. Don't be surprised to hear of a Mobile First Aid Unit in Klamath Falls before spring.

Cars, trucks or motorcycles be-

longing to such a unit are permitted to attach to the vehicle an enameled metal marker signifying that the operator is qualified to render emergency first aid. Uniformed employees who are qualified are also permitted to wear sleeve insignia. We have all seen this marker on the arms of police officers. Chief Frank Hanna is hoping to see every man on his force qualified in first aid. He is cooperating with the school that is now in progress.

Four-H clubs in sewing are being organized in both the Mills and Fairview schools. Clifford Jenkins, county club leader, is

cooperating with the teachers and the Parent-Teacher organizations in getting the work started. Leaders are being found in the communities. The youngsters are enthusiastic about the start that is being made.
