INDUSTRY, RAIL STOCKS BOOST MARKET LEVEL

NEW YORK, March 6 (AP)—Buying of industrials and rails turned the tide for the stock market today and leading issues pushed up fractions to 2 or more points.

Transfers for the full proceedings were in the neighborhood of 450,000 shares.

Principal inspiration for the about-face brokers said, was the belief of technicians the list had been "oversold."

Mild stimulation, however, was discovered in a batch of optimistic earnings statements and dividends, in addition to a more hopeful view of business generally.

Prominent on the recovery shift were shares of US Steel, Bethlehem, Youngstown Sheet, Crucible Steel, Chrysler, General Motors, White Motors, Douglas Aircraft, Boeing, United Aircraft, Anaconda, Kennecott, American Smelting, Loft, Westinghouse, Du Pont, Union Carbide, Eastman Kodak, Santa Fe and Great Northern.
