STOCK MARKET RALLY TRAILS STEEL, SUGAR

NEW YORK, March 10 (AP)—The stock market tied into a rally today behind steels, sugars and specialties.

Gains at the best ranged from fractions to more than 3 points and most were well-maintained at the close.

Transfers approximated 550,000 shares.

Bullishness revived, brokers said, mainly because of expectations the British-aid bill would quickly become law and touch off a further burst of defense spending that would seep into virtually all lines of industry.

Steels responded to the official estimate putting this week's mill operations up 1.3 points at 98.8 per cent of capacity, the highest output rate yet recorded for this field.

Renewed strength of commodities, with cotton futures pushing up briskly, brightened the financial picture.

Apparently restraining some potential share purchasers were unsettled conditions in the Balkans and the far east, together with fears of the effects of spreading strikes on the armament program.

Stocks well in front most of the day were U. S. Steel, Bethlehem, Youngstown Sheet, Republic Steel, American Telephone, Western Union, U. S. Rubber, Santa Fe, Great Northern, Douglas Aircraft, United Aircraft, Westinghouse, General Electric, Eastman Kodak, N. Y. Shipbuilding and Bath Iron Works.

Carrier loans stood out in a generally improved bond division.
