

### Top Irish Stew With Nifty Biscuits Like Shamrocks



Waffles with rich sauce hit right note for late snacks.

For St. Patrick's day, or any other day, this economy meat cut stew is good value. The shamrock biscuit cover adds an appropriate note.

**Irish Stew** (Serves 4 to 6) Two pounds lamb (breast, shank, shoulder or neck), 1 teaspoon salt, 4 teaspoon pepper, flour, 3 tablespoons fat or bacon drippings, 12 small onions, 6 carrots, 6 small potatoes, 2 cups water, 2 cups cooked peas. Cut meat in 1-inch pieces. Mix flour and salt and pepper and dredge the lamb squares in the mixture. Heat fat in an iron skillet and brown the meat lightly. Add water, peeled onions, and carrots, which have been scraped and cut in half, lengthwise. Cover. Simmer for 2 hours. Add potatoes, cubed, and cook for another half hour. Add peas, mix well, and turn the stew into a casserole. Top with biscuit dough, cut in shamrock shape, place the casserole in hot oven (425 degrees F.) and bake for 20 minutes or until the biscuits are done and nicely browned.

**Shamrock Biscuit Topping For Stew** One cup sifted flour, 1 1/2 teaspoons phosphate baking powder, 1/2 teaspoon salt, 3 tablespoons shortening, 1-3 cup milk (about). Sift together flour, phosphate baking powder and salt. Cut in shortening until mixture resembles coarse meal. Add milk to form a soft dough. Turn out on floured surface and knead gently for 30 seconds. Roll out to 1/4

inch thickness. With a shamrock-shaped cookie-cutter, cut three shamrocks in the middle of the dough, the stem ends touching each other. Lift the biscuit dough carefully (use a spatula to hold the shamrock pieces in place) to the top of the casserole. Trim off edge around the casserole with a sharp knife.
