(Serves 4 to 6)

Two pounds lamb (breast, shoulder or neck), 1 teaspoon salt, 1 teaspoon pepper, flour, 3 tablespoons fat or bacon flour, 6 mix ingredients in order given.

Cut meat in 1-inch pieces. Mix flour and salt and pepper and dredge the lamb squares in the mixture. Heat fat in an iron skillet and brown the meat lightly. Add water, peeled onions, and carrots, which have been scraped and cut in half, lengthwise. Cover. Simpser for. lengthwise. Cover. Simmer for 2 hours. Add potatoes, cubed; and cook for another half hour. Add peas, mix well, and turn the stew into a casserole. Top with biscuit dough, cut in shamrock shape, place the casserole in hot oven (425 degrees F.) and bake for 20 minutes or until the bis-cuits are done and nicely browned.

One cup sifted flour, 15 tea-

Sift together flour, phosphate baking powder and salt. Cut in shortening until mixture resembles coarse meal, add milk to make a soft dough. Turn out on floured surface and knead gently for 30 seconds. Roll out to 1




