

SOVIET-JAPAN PACT TERMED SAFETY MOVE

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Such explanation as has been vouchsafed regarding the Russo-Japanese neutrality pact leaves much to the imagination, but on the whole one gets a picture of the two nations safeguarding themselves against possible developments without committing themselves to any definite line of action outside the neutrality bond.

In other words, on the face of it the pact doesn't seem to alter the status of either nation toward the axis powers or the allies. It is clear, however, that under certain circumstances it might alter the status immeasurably.

For instance, should Japan become involved in war with either the United States or Britain in the Far East, Russian neutrality would be a godsend to Nippon, and it certainly would work to the advantage of the Berlin-Rome axis.

On the other hand, the pact gives Russia more leeway to pursue the stiffened attitude which she has adopted toward Germany since Hitler struck southward in the Balkans. That would benefit the allies. The agreement also would afford the soviet protection in the event that the nazis should attempt to annex the rich Russian Ukraine, as British Premier Churchill last week warned Moscow might happen.

One thing is certain — that pact wasn't signed because of affection between the two nations. It obviously is based on quid pro quo. And there is no present indication that it holds out any promises either to the allies or the axis, but is based purely on self-interest and looks toward possibilities rather than certainties.

Japan perhaps will feel a bit more free to pursue her program of extending her sphere of influence in east Asia. It is difficult to believe, however, that she proposes to challenge either the United States or Britain before the trend of European war has been made clear.

Until she is completely satisfied that Germany is winning hands down, Nippon isn't likely to do anything to involve her in war with the allies or America. It might be a far different story if the time should arrive when it was apparent that Hitler would be the victor.

The position of Moscow remains as enigmatic as ever. Still, there are no signs that Communist Chief Stalin intends to abandon his policy of neutrality at this juncture, although there are many indications of his displeasure with nazism, and he has promised material aid to Turkey if she is involved in the Hitlerian conquest.

The Salvation Army drive for funds last October did not net sufficient funds to complete the work necessary in the building by contract, so the Carpenters union agreed to donate the carpentering work, thus saving the Army that much cash outlay.

STEEL FIRMS GRANT HOURLY WAGE BOOSTS

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an-hour boost in basic wages among its 90,000 employees.

Bethlehem holds \$1,500,000,000 in government contracts. US Steel has \$540,000,000 worth of defense assignments.

Three other steel firms announced similar pay boosts. These included Republic Steel corporation, with 50,000 employees; Youngstown (O.) Sheet and Tube company, employed 25,000 men, and the Otis Steel company, Cleveland, with 6000 workers.

Six companies, headed by Ernest T. Weir and the national Steel corporation, announced the 10-cent hourly increase last week. Mondays action brought virtually all important steel producers into accord on the wage issue.

The increase will give workmen an estimated \$100,000,000 greater income in 1941. US Steel will pay about \$54,000,000 more; Bethlehem, \$18,700,000; Republic, \$10,500,000, and the others an estimated \$20,000,000. The increases were retroactive to April 1.

An almost total work-stoppage in the major soft coal fields continued for the 14th day and negotiations between operators and the United Mine Workers (CIO) still were deadlocked.

Operators in 13 southern districts of the Appalachian mining region steadfastly refused to negotiate a new contract calling for a \$1.40 per day wage boost for their employees.

Northern operators in the Appalachian area, employing 250,000 of the 400,000 idle miners, informally agreed to the wage boost, costing them only \$1 per day above present rates. Operators from Indiana and Illinois sided with the northern owners Monday, pleading for early termination of the dispute and elimination of "sectional prejudice."

The northern Appalachian districts and Illinois and Indiana produce about 70 per cent of the nation's soft coal. An agreement with the UMW-CIO in these areas would assure soft coal for steel plants, where the shortage already has been felt.

At Detroit, partial production was resumed at the Ford Motor company's River Rouge plant after a 13-day shutdown. But in the vast General Motors empire, United Automobile Workers (CIO) locals authorized strike action April 20 if their contract with the 70 GMC plants is not renewed.

US labor department officials were scheduled to sit in on GMC-union discussions in an effort to speed an agreement averting repetition of violent General Motors strikes of 1937.

Fourteen strikes were in progress at defense plants Monday night, all of them minor.
