It was somewhat dull in business at Klamath Falls during January, the muddy roads being the principal cause. But business is now reviving, and will soon be all that could be expected. The same may probably be said as to the other towns in the county.

The assassination of Gobel in Kentucky last week brought that state to the verge of civil war, but cool heads and wise counsel from the leaders of both parties, have from latest accounts, probably averted in a great measure the danger of more bloodshed.

It is to be greatly hoped that the political uproar in Kentucky will be settled without further trouble and bloodshed. That Gov. Taylor was fairly and legally elected, cannot be doubted by any fair minded man, who has impartially watched the proceedings.

Nothing definite is reported as to the movements of the British and Boers in Africa, since the defeat of Gen. Buller last week. It is rumored however that he is now making another advance to relieve Ladysmith, and that another great battle may be fought in a few days.

J. D. Whitman of Medford, the gentleman who has commenced the business of canning for market the fish of Lost River, is in town on Monday. Lost River is one of the greatest producers of fish to be found on the continent. Excellent fish they are, and we hope the Lost River canning business will prove a financial success.

The electric lights which have been in mourning during Monday and Tuesday evenings have since been serenely and we believe joyfully shining with all their old time brilliancy. One does not realize the value of a thing until deprived of it, and hence we all realize the importance of electric lights the more because an accident raised the devil with the machinery and left us to grope in darkness for a couple of nights.

The A. O. U. W. lodge at Klamath Falls is moving forward with giant strides. On Tuesday evening it had 7 new members, and we learn that next week 16 from Bonanza and 22 from Fort Klamath will join. There are already about 125 members, and these new additions will place the membership in the vicinity of 160. And it may be expected that the rush will continue. The lodge room, the best and largest in this part of the

state, will soon be found not large enough. There is talk of having a gallery around it on three sides, and this is likely to be done. The lodge will soon number more members than any lodge in Oregon.

Last week one paper said we are "democrats in disguise," and were "out for stuff." Another offered to bet that its circulation was greater than ours. And from both were complaints which they probably deemed pertinent. In the rush of business this week, as will be seen in these columns, we have found no time nor space to devote to our contemporaries, but will gladly do so when there is anything worth answering.
