These are sectional maps of the entire territory included within the boundaries of Klamath County, Oregon, showing wagon roads and railroads, cities, towns, settlements, valleys, mountain ranges with elevation of principal peaks, rivers, creeks, lakes, marshes, main ditches of the irrigation project, the Klamath Indian reservation, the permanent forest reserve, Crater Lake Park and many other features of the topography. These maps are blue prints and may be had in two sizes. The large size, 4 feet-3 inches wide, by 6 feet, 4 inches high, is made on a scale of one and one-half miles to the inch. Price, \$10. The small size, 10 inches wide by 15 inches high, is made on a scale of one-eighth inch to the mile and costs \$2.


